



HOUSE BILL No. 4483

February 28, 1995, Introduced by Rep. Ciaramitaro and referred to the Committee on Judiciary and Civil Rights.

A bill to amend section 15a of chapter IV of Act No. 175 of the Public Acts of 1927, entitled as amended "The code of criminal procedure," as amended by Act No. 66 of the Public Acts of 1994, being section 764.15a of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Section 15a of chapter IV of Act No. 175 of the
2 Public Acts of 1927, as amended by Act No. 66 of the Public Acts
3 of 1994, being section 764.15a of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is
4 amended to read as follows:

5 CHAPTER IV

6 Sec. 15a. A peace officer may arrest an individual for vio-
7 lating section 81 or 81a of the Michigan penal code, Act No. 328
8 of the Public Acts of 1931, ~~as amended,~~ being sections 750.81
9 and 750.81a of the Michigan Compiled Laws, OR A LOCAL ORDINANCE

1 SUBSTANTIALLY CORRESPONDING TO SECTION 81 OF ACT NO. 328 OF THE
2 PUBLIC ACTS OF 1931 regardless of whether the peace officer has a
3 warrant or whether the violation was committed in his or her
4 presence, if the peace officer has reasonable cause to believe
5 both of the following:

- 6 (a) ~~That the~~ THE violation occurred or is occurring.
7 (b) ~~That the~~ THE individual has had a child in common with
8 the victim, resides or has resided in the same household as the
9 victim, or is a spouse or former spouse of the victim.
