March 14, 1995, Introduced by Reps. Perricone, Profit, Middaugh, Gernaat, Jaye, Bullard and Cropsey and referred to the Committee on Appropriations.

A bill to amend sections 351, 353, and 356 of Act No. 431 of the Public Acts of 1984, entitled as amended
"The management and budget act,"
section 353 as amended by Act No. 107 of the Public Acts of 1994, being sections 18.1351, 18.1353, and 18.1356 of the Michigan
Compiled Laws; and to add section 352a.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Section 1. Sections 351, 353, and 356 of Act No. 431 of the
- 2 Public Acts of 1984, section 353 as amended by Act No. 107 of the
- 3 Public Acts of 1994, being sections 18.1351, 18.1353, and 18.1356
- 4 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, are amended and section 352a is
- 5 added to read as follows:

- 7 stabilization fund is created to assist in stabilizing revenue,

- Sec. 353. (1) In a calendar quarter following a calendar

(2) The legislature may appropriate by law money from the 15 -fund- ECONOMIC STABILIZATION ACCOUNT in the amounts as provided in this section to assist in the following countercyclical economic stabilization purposes:

- (b) Public works and public service jobs.
- (c) Refundable investment or employment tax credits against
