



HOUSE BILL No. 4634

March 21, 1995, Introduced by Reps. Martinez, Baird, Gire, Hanley, Brater, LaForge, Schroer, Cherry, Price, Scott, Kilpatrick, Agee, Anthony, Leland and DeMars and referred to the Committee on Insurance.

A bill to amend Act No. 218 of the Public Acts of 1956, entitled as amended "The insurance code of 1956," as amended, being sections 500.100 to 500.8302 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, by adding section 2027a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Act No. 218 of the Public Acts of 1956, as
2 amended, being sections 500.100 to 500.8302 of the Michigan
3 Compiled Laws, is amended by adding section 2027a to read as
4 follows:

5 SEC. 2027A. (1) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SECTION 3408, ISSUING
6 A DISABILITY POLICY OR CERTIFICATE THAT EXCLUDES, LIMITS, OR
7 REDUCES COVERAGE FOR ANY OF THE FOLLOWING IS AN UNFAIR METHOD OF

1 COMPETITION AND AN UNFAIR OR DECEPTIVE ACT OR PRACTICE IN THE
2 BUSINESS OF INSURANCE:

3 (A) THE HEPATITIS B VIRUS OR HIV.

4 (B) A RECORD OF 1 OR MORE PHYSICAL INJURIES SUSTAINED BY THE
5 INSURED THAT WERE INTENTIONALLY INFLICTED BY A FAMILY MEMBER OR
6 ACQUAINTANCE OF THE INSURED.

7 (2) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "HIV" MEANS THAT TERM AS
8 DEFINED IN SECTION 5101 OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH CODE, ACT NO. 368 OF
9 THE PUBLIC ACTS OF 1978, BEING SECTION 333.5101 OF THE MICHIGAN
10 COMPILED LAWS.
