



# HOUSE BILL No. 4641

March 21, 1995, Introduced by Reps. Dalman, Middaugh, Cropsey, McBryde, McManus, Goschka, DeLange and Walberg and referred to the Committee on Higher Education.

A bill to amend section 95 of Act No. 94 of the Public Acts of 1979, entitled as amended

"The state school aid act of 1979,"

as amended by Act No. 283 of the Public Acts of 1994, being section 388.1695 of the Michigan Compiled Laws; to add section 22a; and to repeal acts and parts of acts.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1       Section 1. Section 95 of Act No. 94 of the Public Acts of  
2 1979, as amended by Act No. 283 of the Public Acts of 1994, being  
3 section 388.1695 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended and  
4 section 22a is added to read as follows:

5       SEC. 22A. (1) FROM THE AMOUNT APPROPRIATED UNDER  
6 SECTION 11, THERE IS ALLOCATED \$\_\_\_\_\_ FOR MAKING COLLEGE LEVEL  
7 EQUIVALENT INCENTIVE AWARD PAYMENTS AS PROVIDED IN SECTION 1473  
8 OF THE SCHOOL CODE OF 1976, BEING SECTION 380.1473 OF THE

1 MICHIGAN COMPILED LAWS. IN ADDITION, \$\_\_\_\_\_ IS APPROPRIATED FOR  
2 THAT PURPOSE FROM THE COLLEGE LEVEL EQUIVALENT INCENTIVE FUND  
3 ESTABLISHED UNDER SECTION 1474 OF THE SCHOOL CODE OF 1976, BEING  
4 SECTION 380.1474 OF THE MICHIGAN COMPILED LAWS.

5 (2) A DISTRICT SHALL USE FUNDS RECEIVED UNDER SECTION 20 TO  
6 PAY EXAMINATION FEES FOR COLLEGE LEVEL EQUIVALENT CREDIT EXAMINA-  
7 TIONS AS PROVIDED IN SECTION 1475 OF THE SCHOOL CODE OF 1976,  
8 BEING SECTION 380.1475 OF THE MICHIGAN COMPILED LAWS.

9 (3) THIS SECTION IS REPEALED EFFECTIVE JUNE 30, 2001.

10 Sec. 95. (1) From the appropriations in section 11, there  
11 is allocated \$8,000,000.00 from the state school aid fund appro-  
12 priation and \$2,000,000.00 from the general fund appropriation  
13 for 1994-95 for professional development for teachers and others  
14 within the educational community. The total allocation under  
15 this section shall be distributed as follows:

16 (a) \$6,500,000.00 is allocated from the state school aid  
17 fund to districts on a per pupil basis, with each district  
18 receiving the same amount per pupil.

19 (b) \$1,500,000.00 is allocated from the state school aid  
20 fund to intermediate districts on a per pupil basis for each  
21 pupil in membership in the intermediate district or in a constit-  
22 uent district, with each intermediate district receiving the same  
23 amount per pupil.

24 (c) \$2,000,000.00 is allocated from the general fund to the  
25 department for statewide professional development initiatives.

26 (2) The professional development funds allocated under this  
27 section may be used for any of the following:

1 (a) Advancement of the initiatives under sections 1204a,  
 2 1277, 1278, and 1280 of the school code of 1976, being  
 3 sections 380.1204a, 380.1277, 380.1278, and 380.1280 of the  
 4 Michigan Compiled Laws, commonly referred to as "Public Act 25 of  
 5 1990".

6 (b) Improving instructional and support staff skills.

7 (C) COLLEGE LEVEL EQUIVALENT COURSE TEACHER TRAINING.

8 (D) ~~(e)~~ Other areas of professional development identified  
 9 in the school code of 1976.

10 (3) Not later than 60 days after the end of each fiscal  
 11 year, an intermediate district, in cooperation with its constitu-  
 12 ent districts, shall prepare and submit to the house and senate  
 13 K-12 appropriations subcommittees, the house and senate fiscal  
 14 agencies, the department, and the department of management and  
 15 budget a report of not more than 15 pages listing and describing  
 16 the intermediate district's and its constituent districts' expen-  
 17 ditures of funds allocated under this section and the activities  
 18 for which the funds were expended.

19 Section 2. This amendatory act shall not take effect unless  
 20 all of the following bills of the 88th Legislature are enacted  
 21 into law:
