

HOUSE BILL No. 4828

May 16, 1995, Introduced by Reps. Mathieu, Voorhees and Jaye and referred to the Committee on Local Government.

A bill to amend sections 10 and 12 of Act No. 261 of the Public Acts of 1966, entitled as amended

"An act to provide for the apportionment of county boards of commissioners; to prescribe the size of the board; to provide for appeals; to prescribe the manner of election of the members of the county board of commissioners; to provide for compensation of members; and to repeal certain acts and parts of acts,"

section 12 as amended by Act No. 504 of the Public Acts of 1982, being sections 46.410 and 46.412 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Section 1. Sections 10 and 12 of Act No. 261 of the Public
- 2 Acts of 1966, section 12 as amended by Act No. 504 of the Public

- 4 Compiled Laws, are amended to read as follows:
- 5 Sec. 10. (1) The term of each COUNTY commissioner ELECTED
- 6 IN THE 1994 GENERAL NOVEMBER ELECTION shall be concurrent with

- 3 (2) THE REGULAR ELECTION OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS SHALL TAKE
- 4 PLACE AT THE GENERAL NOVEMBER ELECTION HELD IN 1996 AND EVERY 4
- 5 YEARS THEREAFTER. THE TERM OF EACH COUNTY COMMISSIONER ELECTED
- 6 AT THE REGULAR ELECTION OF COMMISSIONERS IN 1996 OR THEREAFTER
- 7 SHALL BE 4 YEARS AND SHALL COMMENCE ON JANUARY 1 IMMEDIATELY FOL-

- 12 COMMISSIONER FOR A PERIOD GREATER THAN 2 YEARS SHALL BE CONSID-
- 13 ERED TO HAVE BEEN ELECTED TO SERVE 1 TIME IN THAT OFFICE FOR PUR-
- 14 POSES OF THIS SUBSECTION. THE LIMITATION ON THE NUMBER OF TIMES
- 15 A PERSON MAY BE ELECTED TO THE OFFICE OF COMMISSIONER SHALL APPLY
- 16 TO TERMS OF OFFICE BEGINNING ON OR AFTER JANUARY 1, 1997.
- 17 Sec. 12. (1) When IF a vacancy occurs in the office of
- 18 COUNTY commissioner by death, resignation, removal from the dis-
- 19 trict, or removal from office, the vacancy shall be filled by
- 20 appointment within 30 days by the county board of commissioners
- 21 of a resident and registered voter of that district. A person
