

## **HOUSE BILL No. 4955**

June 13, 1995, Introduced by Reps. McNutt, Middaugh, Perricone, Dalman, Bodem, Jersevic, Lowe, Goschka, Rhead, Walberg, Voorhees, Gernaat, Hill, Jaye, Cherry, Randall, Dobb, Geiger, DeLange, Ryan, London, Whyman, Munsell, Galloway and Llewellyn and referred to the Committee on Judiciary and Civil Rights.

A bill to amend section 1a of Act No. 253 of the Public Acts of 1935, entitled as amended

"The state correctional facility reimbursement act," as added by Act No. 282 of the Public Acts of 1984, being section 800.401a of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Section 1. Section 1a of Act No. 253 of the Public Acts of
- 2 1935, as added by Act No. 282 of the Public Acts of 1984, being
- 3 section 800.401a of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended to
- 4 read as follows:
- 5 Sec. 1a. As used in this act:
- 6 (a) "Assets" means property, tangible or intangible, real or
- 7 personal, belonging to or due a prisoner or former prisoner
- 8 including income or payments to such prisoner from social
- 9 security, worker's compensation, veteran's compensation, pension

- 1 benefits, previously earned salary or wages, bonuses, annuities.
- 2 retirement benefits, or from any other source whatsoever, but
- 3 does not include any of the following:
- 4 (i) The homestead of the prisoner up to \$50,000.00 in 5 value.
- 6 (ii) Money received by the prisoner from the state as set-7 tlement of a claim against the department by the prisoner.
- 8 (iii) A money judgment received by the prisoner from the 9 state as the result of a civil action in which the department was 10 a named defendant and found to be liable.
- (iv) Money saved by the prisoner from wages and bonuses paid the prisoner while he or she was confined to a state correctional facility.
- (b) "Cost of care" means the cost to the department —of

  15 corrections—for providing transportation, room, board, clothing,

  16 security, medical, and other normal living expenses of prisoners,

  17 under the jurisdiction of the department—AND THE COST TO THE

  18 DEPARTMENT FOR PROVIDING COLLEGE-LEVEL CLASSES OR PROGRAMS TO

  19 PRISONERS, as determined by the commission of corrections—
- 21 (c) "Department" means the department of corrections of this
  22 state.
- 23 (d) "Director" means the director of the department.
- (e) "Prisoner" means any person who is under the jurisdic25 tion of the department and is either confined in any state cor26 rectional facility or is under the continuing jurisdiction of the
- 27 department.

(f) "State correctional facility" means a facility or institution which houses a prisoner population under the jurisdiction of the department. State correctional facility includes a correctional camp, community correction center, state prison, and a state reformatory.
