A bill to amend Act No. 280 of the Public Acts of 1939, entitled as amended

"The social welfare act,"

as amended, being sections 400.1 to 400.119b of the Michigan Compiled Laws, by adding section 57a.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Section 1. Act No. 280 of the Public Acts of 1939, as
- 2 amended, being sections 400.1 to 400.119b of the Michigan
- 3 Compiled Laws, is amended by adding section 57a to read as
- 4 follows:
- 5 SEC. 57A. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL REQUIRE AS A CONDITION OF
- 6 ELIGIBILITY FOR AID TO FAMILIES WITH DEPENDENT CHILDREN OR STATE
- 7 FAMILY ASSISTANCE THAT A RECIPIENT UNDER THE AGE OF 19 WHO DOES
- 8 NOT HAVE A HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA OR A GENERAL EDUCATION DEVELOPMENT
