



HOUSE BILL No. 4965

June 14, 1995, Introduced by Rep. Bryant and referred to the Committee on Education.

A bill to amend Act No. 451 of the Public Acts of 1976,
entitled as amended
"The school code of 1976,"
as amended, being sections 380.1 to 380.1852 of the Michigan
Compiled Laws, by adding section 1531d.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Act No. 451 of the Public Acts of 1976, as
2 amended, being sections 380.1 to 380.1852 of the Michigan
3 Compiled Laws, is amended by adding section 1531d to read as
4 follows:

5 SEC. 1531D. (1) THE STATE BOARD MAY APPROVE FOR TEACHER
6 CERTIFICATION PURPOSES A PROGRAM OPERATED BY AN INTERMEDIATE
7 SCHOOL DISTRICT OR CONSORTIUM OF INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICTS
8 THAT IS DESIGNED TO PROVIDE FOR PERSONS WHO ALREADY POSSESS AT
9 LEAST A BACHELOR'S DEGREE AND WHO HAVE RELEVANT OCCUPATIONAL

1 EXPERIENCE, ON AN EXPEDITED BASIS, REQUIRED TEACHER EDUCATION,
2 DIRECTED TEACHING EXPERIENCE, AND OTHER TRAINING REQUIRED FOR
3 TEACHER CERTIFICATION. THE STATE BOARD MAY PRESCRIBE PROGRAM
4 ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS AND CURRICULUM STANDARDS FOR SUCH A
5 PROGRAM. IF THE STATE BOARD APPROVES A PROGRAM DESCRIBED IN THIS
6 SECTION, THE STATE BOARD SHALL CONSIDER THE PROGRAM TO BE AN
7 APPROVED TEACHER EDUCATION INSTITUTION FOR ALL PURPOSES RELATED
8 TO TEACHER CERTIFICATION.

9 (2) WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE STATE BOARD, AN INTERMEDIATE
10 SCHOOL DISTRICT OR CONSORTIUM OF INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICTS
11 MAY OPERATE A PROGRAM DESCRIBED IN THIS SECTION.
