

## **HOUSE BILL No. 5039**

September 13, 1995, Introduced by Rep. McBryde and referred to the Committee on Judiciary and Civil Rights.

A bill to amend section 2 of Act No. 203 of the Public Acts of 1965, entitled

"Michigan law enforcement officers training council act of 1965," as amended by Act No. 155 of the Public Acts of 1994, being section 28.602 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Section 1. Section 2 of Act No. 203 of the Public Acts of
- 2 1965, as amended by Act No. 155 of the Public Acts of 1994, being
- 3 section 28.602 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended to read
- 4 as follows:
- 5 Sec. 2. As used in this act:
- 6 (a) "Council" means the law enforcement council created in7 section 3.
- 8 (b) "Executive secretary" means the executive secretary of
- 9 the council appointed under section 12.

- 1 (c) "Law enforcement officer of a Michigan Indian tribal
  2 police force" means a regularly employed member of a police force
  3 of a Michigan Indian tribe who is appointed pursuant to -25
- 4 C.F.R. 11.301 to 11.304 TITLE 25 OF THE CODE OF FEDERAL
- 5 REGULATIONS.
- 6 (d) "Michigan Indian tribe" means a federally recognized
  7 Indian tribe that has trust lands located within this state.
- 8 (e) "Police officer" or "law enforcement officer" means,
- 9 unless the context requires otherwise, either of the following:
- (i) A member of a police force or other organization of a
- 11 city, county, township, or village, or of the state, regularly
- 12 employed as such, who is responsible for the prevention and
- 13 detection of crime and the enforcement of the general criminal
- 14 laws of this state, but does not include a person serving as such
- 15 solely by virtue of his or her occupying any other office or
- 16 position.
- 17 (ii) A law enforcement officer of a Michigan Indian tribal
- 18 police force, subject to the limitations set forth in
- 19 section 9(3).
