

HOUSE BILL No. 5115

A bill to amend section 1 of Act No. 313 of the Public Acts of 1966, entitled as amended

"An act to award tuition grants to resident students enrolled in independent nonprofit institutions of higher learning; and to make an appropriation therefor,"

as amended by Act No. 503 of the Public Acts of 1980, being section 390.991 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:
