



HOUSE BILL No. 5116

September 21, 1995, Introduced by Reps. Hanley, Cherry, Baird, Porreca, Tesanovich, DeHart, Kelly, McBryde, Martinez, Willard, LaForge, Gire, Pitoniak, DeMars, Leland, Weeks, Prusi, Brater, Parks, Freeman, Scott, Schroer and Wallace and referred to the Committee on Judiciary and Civil Rights.

A bill to amend section 3 of Act No. 273 of the Public Acts of 1986, entitled

"An act to establish a Michigan educational opportunity grant program for resident qualified students enrolled in eligible public postsecondary schools; and to prescribe the powers and duties of certain state agencies,"

being section 390.1403 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Section 3 of Act No. 273 of the Public Acts of
2 1986, being section 390.1403 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is
3 amended to read as follows:

4 Sec. 3. (1) A recognized postsecondary school in this state
5 is eligible to participate in the MEOG program under this act if
6 the postsecondary school is a degree-granting public institution
7 approved by the state board of education AND IS IN COMPLIANCE
8 WITH THE MICHIGAN CAMPUS SEXUAL ASSAULT INFORMATION ACT.

1 (2) A grant shall not be made under this act to a student
2 who is enrolled in a program of study leading to a degree in the-
3 ology, divinity, or religious education.

4 Section 2. This amendatory act shall not take effect unless
5 Senate Bill No. _____ or House Bill No. 5119 (request
6 no. 00189'95) of the 88th Legislature is enacted into law.
