

HOUSE BILL No. 5129

September 26, 1995, Introduced by Reps. Perricone, LaForge, Gilmer, Jersevic, Green, Bullard, Pitoniak, Gnodtke and Anthony and referred to the Committee on Local Government.

A bill to amend section 10 of Act No. 156 of the Public Acts of 1851, entitled as amended

"An act to define the powers and duties of the county boards of commissioners of the several counties, and to confer upon them certain local, administrative and legislative powers; and to prescribe penalties for the violation of the provisions of this act."

being section 46.10 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Section 1. Section 10 of Act No. 156 of the Public Acts of
- 2 1851, being section 46.10 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is
- 3 amended to read as follows:
- 4 Sec. 10. A special meeting of the county board of commis-
- 5 sioners of a county shall be held only when requested by at least
- 6 1/3 of the members of the county board of commissioners of the
- 7 county. The request shall be in writing, shall be addressed to
- 8 the county clerk, and shall specify the time, date, place, and

- 1 purpose of the meeting. Upon the reception of a request, the
- 2 clerk shall -immediately give notice -in writing to each of the
- 3 commissioners by causing the same to be delivered to the commis-
- 4 sioners personally, or by leaving the same at the place of resi-
- 5 dence of the commissioner, or by mailing a copy of the notice to
- 6 his or her post office address by certified mail with return
- 7 receipt requested, at least +0 days before the time of the
- 8 meeting IN THE MANNER REQUIRED BY THE BYLAWS OF THE COUNTY BOARD
- 9 OF COMMISSIONERS. Public notice of the time, date, and place of
- 10 the meeting shall be given in the manner required by THE OPEN
- 11 MEETINGS ACT, Act No. 267 of the Public Acts of 1976, BEING SEC-
- 12 TIONS 15.261 TO 15.275 OF THE MICHIGAN COMPILED LAWS.
