

HOUSE BILL No. 5131

September 26, 1995, Introduced by Reps. Perricone, Jersevic, Rhead, Green, Profit, Anthony, Gnodtke and Goschka and referred to the Committee on Tax Policy.

A bill to amend section 51 of Act No. 150 of the Public Acts of 1927, entitled as amended

"An act to prescribe a privilege tax for the use of the public highways by owners and drivers of motor vehicles by imposing a specific tax upon the sale or use, within the state of Michigan, of motor fuel; to prescribe the manner and the time of paying this tax and the duties of officials and others respecting the payment and collection of this tax; to provide for the licensing of wholesale distributors, certain retail dealers, exporters, and suppliers as defined in this act; to fix a time when this tax and interest and penalties thereon become a lien upon the property of persons, firms, partnerships, associations, or corporations, subject to the payment of this tax; to provide for the enforcement of this lien; to permit the inspection and testing of petroleum products; to provide for certain exemptions and refunds and for the disposition of the proceeds of this tax; and to prescribe penalties for the violation of this act,"

being section 207.151 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Section 1. Section 51 of Act No. 150 of the Public Acts of
- 2 1927, being section 207.151 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is
- 3 amended to read as follows:

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- 1 Sec. 51. (1) The provisions of THIS chapter 3 of this
- 2 act shall apply only to liquefied petroleum gas and the defini-
- 3 tions in this section shall apply only to THIS chapter. 3 of
- 4 this act.
- 5 (2) AS USED IN THIS CHAPTER:
- 6 (A) "Liquefied petroleum gas" -shall be deemed to mean
- 7 gases MEANS A GAS derived from petroleum or natural gases which
- 8 are in the gaseous state at normal atmospheric temperature and
- 9 pressure, but which may be maintained in the liquid state at
- 10 normal atmospheric temperature by suitable pressure. The term
- 11 -shall be deemed to include INCLUDES those products predomi-
- 12 nately composed of propane, propylene, butylene, butane, and sim-
- 13 ilar products not covered in chapter 1 and chapter 2. of Act
- 14 No. 150 of the Public Acts of 1927, as amended. FOR PURPOSES OF
- 15 THE TAX IMPOSED BY THIS CHAPTER, LIQUEFIED PETROLEUM GAS DOES NOT
- 16 INCLUDE PROPANE USED AS THE FUEL SOURCE OF A MOTOR VEHICLE.
- 17 (B) "Use" shall mean and include OR "USING" INCLUDES:
- 18 -(1)
- 19 (i) Selling or delivering liquefied petroleum gas not previ-
- 20 ously subjected to tax under -part 2 hereof- CHAPTER 2, either by
- 21 placing it into permanently attached fuel supply tanks of motor
- 22 vehicles, or THROUGH THE exchanging or replacing of the fuel
- 23 supply tanks of a motor vehicle. -, or (2) making
- 24 (ii) MAKING delivery of liquefied petroleum gas into stor-
- 25 age, devoted exclusively to the storage of liquefied petroleum
- 26 gas to be consumed in motor vehicles on the public roads and

1 (iii) THE withdrawal of liquefied petroleum gas from the
2 cargo tank of a truck, trailer, or semi-trailer for the operation
3 of a motor vehicle upon the public roads and highways of this

- 16 (E) "Dealer" shall mean and include any MEANS A person

 17 other than a licensed dealer who engages in the business

 18 of selling or handling of liquefied petroleum gas for any purpose

 19 whatsoever within this state.
- (F) "Public roads and highways" means every way or place
 generally opened to the use of the public as a matter of right
 for the purpose of vehicular travel, notwithstanding that they
 may be temporarily closed or travel thereon restricted for the
 purpose of construction, maintenance, repair, or reconstruction.
- 25 (G) "Person" means and includes a natural person, partner26 ship, firm, association, joint stock company, syndicate, and
 27 corporations OR CORPORATION, and any receiver, trustee,

- 1 conservator, or any other official having jurisdiction or control
- 2 of property by virtue of the provisions of any UNDER law -, or
- 3 by appointment of a court other than units of government.

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
