

HOUSE BILL No. 5137

September 26, 1995, Introduced by Reps. Law, Voorhees and DeMars and referred to the Committee on Human Resources and Labor.

A bill to limit the liability of employers under certain circumstances.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. As used in this act:
- 2 (a) "Employee" means an individual who as a volunteer or for
- 3 compensation provides an employer with his or her labor.
- 4 (b) "Employer" means a person who employs an individual for
- 5 compensation or who supervises an individual providing labor as a
- 6 volunteer.
- 7 (c) "Prospective employer" means a person to whom an
- 8 employee or former employee has submitted an application for
- 9 employment.
- Sec. 2. An employer may disclose to an employee or that
- 11 individual's prospective employer information relating to the
- 12 individual's job performance upon the request of the individual

- I or his or her prospective employer. An employer who discloses
- 2 information under this section in good faith is immune from civil
- 3 liability for the disclosure. An employer is presumed to be
- 4 acting in good faith at the time of a disclosure under this sec-
- 5 tion unless a preponderance of the evidence establishes 1 or more
- 6 of the following:
- 7 (a) That the employer knew the information disclosed was
- 8 false or misleading.
- 9 (b) That the employer disclosed the information with a reck-
- 10 less disregard for the truth.
- (c) That the disclosure was specifically prohibited by a
- 12 state or federal statute.
