



HOUSE BILL No. 5273

October 19, 1995, Introduced by Reps. Geiger and DeMars and referred to the Committee on Appropriations.

A bill to supplement appropriations for the judicial branch for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1996; to provide for the expenditure of these appropriations; to provide for the funding of certain work projects; to provide for the imposition of certain fees; to establish or continue certain funds, programs, and categories; to provide for disposition of year end balances for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1996; and to provide for the disposition of fees and other income received by the various judicial branch entities.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 101. There is appropriated for the judicial branch subject to
2 the conditions set forth in this act, for the fiscal year ending
3 September 30, 1996, the following amounts from the funds identified as
