

HOUSE BILL No. 5287

October 25, 1995, Introduced by Rep. Sikkema and referred to the Committee on Conservation, Environment and Great Lakes.

A bill to amend section 15a of Act No. 293 of the Public Acts of 1966, entitled as amended

"An act to provide for the establishment of charter counties; to provide for the election of charter commissioners; to prescribe their powers and duties; to prohibit certain acts of a county board of commissioners after the approval of the election of a charter commission; to prescribe the mandatory and permissive provisions of a charter; and to provide for the exercise by a charter county of certain powers whether or not authorized by its charter,"

as added by Act No. 20 of the Public Acts of 1994, being section 45.515a of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 15a. (1) Consistent with Act No. 58 of the Public Acts 2 of 1945, being section 46.201 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, and 3 whether or not authorized by the county charter, the county board 4 of commissioners of a county established under this act may adopt 5 an ordinance that designates a violation of the ordinance as a 6 civil infraction and provides a civil fine for that violation. -(2) Consistent with the marine safety act, Act No. 303 of 8 the Public Acts of 1967, being sections 281.1001 to 281.1199 of 9 the Michigan Compiled Laws, and whether or not authorized by the 10 county charter, the county board of commissioners may adopt an 11 ordinance that designates a violation of the ordinance as a 12 marine law civil infraction and provides a civil fine for that 13 violation. This subsection does not apply unless House Bill 14 No. 4639 of the 87th Legislature is enacted into law. (2) -(3) Whether or not authorized by the the county 15 16 charter, the county board of commissioners may adopt an ordinance 17 that designates a violation of the ordinance as a municipal civil 18 infraction and provides a civil fine for that violation. 19 ordinance may not designate a violation as a municipal civil 20 infraction if that violation may be designated as a civil infrac-21 tion under subsection (1). or as a marine law civil infraction 22 under subsection (2). A statute may provide that a violation of 23 a specific type of ordinance is a municipal civil infraction 24 whether or not the ordinance designates the violation as a munic-25 ipal civil infraction.

- 1 (3) -(4) An ordinance shall not make an act or omission a 2 municipal civil infraction if that act or omission constitutes a 3 crime under any of the following:
- (a) Article 7 or section 17766a of the public health code, 5 Act No. 368 of the Public Acts of 1978, being sections 333.7101 6 to 333.7545 and 333.17766a of the Michigan Compiled Laws.
