

## **HOUSE BILL No. 5288**

October 25, 1995, Introduced by Rep. Sikkema and referred to the Committee on Conservation, Environment and Great Lakes.

A bill to amend section 6a of Act No. 139 of the Public Acts of 1973, entitled

"An act to provide forms of county government; to provide for county managers and county executives and to prescribe their powers and duties; to abolish certain departments, boards, commissions, and authorities; to provide for transfer of certain powers and functions; to prescribe powers of a board of county commissioners and elected officials; to provide organization of administrative functions; to transfer property; to retain ordinances and laws not inconsistent with this act; and to provide methods for abolition of a unified form of county government,"

as added by Act No. 21 of the Public Acts of 1994, being section 45.556a of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Section 1. Section 6a of Act No. 139 of the Public Acts of

- 1 Sec. 6a. (1) Consistent with Act No. 58 of the Public Acts
- 2 of 1945, being section 46.201 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, the
- 3 county board of commissioners may adopt an ordinance that desig-
- 4 nates a violation of the ordinance as a civil infraction and pro-
- 5 vides a civil fine for that violation.
- 6 (2) Consistent with the marine safety act, Act No. 303 of
- 7 the Public Acts of 1967, being sections 281.1001 to 281.1199 of
- 8 the Michigan Compiled Laws, the county board of commissioners may
- 9 adopt an ordinance that designates a violation of the ordinance
- 10 as a marine law civil infraction and provides a civil fine for
- 11 that violation. This subsection does not apply unless House Bill
- 12 No. 4639 of the 87th Legislature is enacted into law.
- 13 (2) -(3) The county board of commissioners may adopt an
- 14 ordinance that designates a violation of the ordinance as a
- 15 municipal civil infraction and provides a civil fine for that
- 16 violation. An ordinance may not designate a violation as a
- 17 municipal civil infraction if that violation may be designated as
- 18 a civil infraction under subsection (1). or as a marine law
- 19 civil infraction under subsection (2). A statute may provide
- 20 that a violation of a specific type of ordinance is a municipal
- 21 civil infraction whether or not the ordinance designates the vio-
- 22 lation as a municipal civil infraction.
- 23 (3) (4) An ordinance shall not make an act or omission a
- 24 municipal civil infraction if that act or omission constitutes a
- 25 crime under any of the following:

- (a) Article 7 or section 17766a of the public health code, 2 Act No. 368 of the Public Acts of 1978, being sections 333.7101 to 333.7545 and 333.17766a of the Michigan Compiled Laws.
- (b) The Michigan penal code, Act No. 328 of the Public Acts of 1931, being sections 750.1 to 750.568 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.
- 7 (c) The Michigan vehicle code, Act No. 300 of the Public 8 Acts of 1949, being sections 257.1 to 257.923 of the Michigan 9 Compiled Laws.
