

HOUSE BILL No. 5301

October 25, 1995, Introduced by Rep. McManus and referred to the Committee on Conservation, Environment and Great Lakes.

A bill to amend section 13 of Act No. 122 of the Public Acts of 1941, entitled as amended

"An act to establish a revenue division of the department of treasury; to prescribe its powers and duties as the revenue collection agency of the state; to prescribe certain powers and duties of the state treasurer; to create the position and to define the powers and duties of the state commissioner of revenue; to provide for the transfer of powers and duties now vested in certain other state boards, commissions, departments and offices; to prescribe certain duties of and require certain reports from the department of treasury; to provide procedures for the payment, administration, audit, assessment, levy of interests or penalties on, and appeals of taxes and tax liability; to provide an appropriation; to abolish the state board of tax administration; and to declare the effect of this act,"

being section 205.13 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Section 1. Section 13 of Act No. 122 of the Public Acts of

- (E) $\overline{(f)}$ The commission shall also succeed to and is hereby
- 13 vested with all of the powers, duties, functions,
- 14 responsibilities, and jurisdiction of the corporation and securi-
- 15 ties commission over the enforcement, investigation, and collec-
- 16 tion of past due and delinquent corporate privilege and franchise
- 17 tees and license fees of any nature. The corporation and securi-
- 18 ties commission shall, whenever requested by the department,
- 19 report to said department the names of all delinquent corpora-
- 20 tions and delinquent licensees, and the department shall be
- 21 charged with the collection of all fees and licenses covered in
- 22 such reports.
- 23 (g) The commission shall succeed to and is hereby vested
- 24 with all the powers, duties, functions, responsibilities and
- 25 jurisdiction of the state treasurer over the collection of delin-
- 26 quent premium taxes from foreign insurance companies, heretofore
- 27 vested in the state treasurer by sections 512.19 and 512.20 of

- 1 the Compiled Laws of 1948, being sections 19 and 20 of part 2,
- 2 chapter 2 of Act No. 256 of the Public Acts of 1917.
- 3 (F) $\frac{h}{h}$ The department shall succeed to and is hereby
- 4 vested with all powers, duties, functions, responsibilities, and
- 5 jurisdiction of the attorney general over the collection of all
- 6 past due -moneys- MONEY and accounts which are owing to the state
- 7 of Michigan or any department, commission, or institution there-
- 8 of, heretofore vested in the attorney general by Act No. 375 of
- 9 the Public Acts of 1927, being sections 14.131 to 14.134 -
- 10 inclusive, of the MICHIGAN Compiled Laws. of 1948.
