



HOUSE BILL No. 5356

October 31, 1995, Introduced by Reps. McNutt, DeLange, Randall, Hill, Rhead, Anthony, Dalman and Kukuk and referred to the Committee on Insurance.

A bill to amend section 3109a of Act No. 218 of the Public Acts of 1956, entitled as amended

"The insurance code of 1956,"

being section 500.3109a of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Section 3109a of Act No. 218 of the Public Acts
2 of 1956, being section 500.3109a of the Michigan Compiled Laws,
3 is amended to read as follows:

4 Sec. 3109a. (1) An insurer providing personal protection
5 insurance benefits shall offer, at appropriately reduced premium
6 rates, deductibles and exclusions reasonably related to other
7 health and accident coverage on the insured. The deductibles and
8 exclusions required to be offered by this section ~~shall be~~ ARE
9 subject to prior approval by the commissioner and ~~shall~~ apply
10 only to benefits payable to the person named in the policy, the

1 spouse of the insured, and any relative of either domiciled in
2 the same household.

3 (2) AN INSURER PROVIDING PERSONAL PROTECTION BENEFITS UNDER
4 AN AUTOMOBILE POLICY THAT IS COORDINATED WITH A HEALTH INSURANCE
5 POLICY, CERTIFICATE, OR CONTRACT OR HEALTH BENEFIT PLAN IS LIABLE
6 FOR MEDICAL EXPENSES AND SERVICES NOT COVERED BY THE POLICY, CER-
7 TIFICATE, CONTRACT, OR PLAN IF PROVIDED BY A HEALTH CARE PROVIDER
8 LICENSED, CERTIFIED, OR REGISTERED UNDER THE PUBLIC HEALTH CODE,
9 ACT NO. 368 OF THE PUBLIC ACTS OF 1978, BEING SECTIONS 333.1101
10 TO 333.25211 OF THE MICHIGAN COMPILED LAWS.
