

## **HOUSE BILL No. 5369**

November 7, 1995, Introduced by Reps. Hill, Bush, Ryan, Galloway, Perricone, Gnodtke, Lowe, Gernaat, Kukuk, McManus, Weeks, Gustafson, Rhead, Hill and Bobier and referred to the Committee on Local Government.

A bill to amend section 6 of chapter IX of Act No. 215 of the Public Acts of 1895, entitled as amended
"The fourth class city act,"
being section 89.6 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Section 1. Section 6 of chapter IX of Act No. 215 of the
- 2 Public Acts of 1895, being section 89.6 of the Michigan Compiled
- 3 Laws, is amended to read as follows:
- 4 CHAPTER IX
- 5 Sec. 6. (1) Within 1 week after the passage of any AN
- 6 ordinance, the same CLERK shall be published in some newspaper
- 7 printed and PUBLISH THE ORDINANCE IN A NEWSPAPER circulated
- 8 within the city. -, and IMMEDIATELY AFTER THE ORDINANCE IS
- 9 PUBLISHED, the clerk shall -immediately after such publication-
- 10 enter -upon- IN the record of ordinances, in a blank space to be

- 1 left for -such THIS purpose under the recorded ordinance, a
- 2 SIGNED certificate stating in what newspaper and of what date
- 3 such publication was made, and sign the same officially, and
- 4 such THE DATE AND NEWSPAPER IN WHICH THE ORDINANCE WAS
- 5 PUBLISHED. THE certificate shall be IS prima facie evidence
- 6 -that OF THE legal publication of -such THE ordinance. -has
- 7 been made: Provided, however, That each city shall have power to
- 8 adopt any plumbing code, electrical code, or building code which
- 9 has been promulgated by the state of Michigan, or by any depart
- 10 ment, board, or other agency thereof, or by any organization or
- 11 association which is organized and conducted for the purpose of
- 12 developing any such code or codes
- 13 (2) A CITY MAY ADOPT A STATUTE OF THIS STATE, A RULE PROMUL-
- 14 GATED BY AN AGENCY OF THIS STATE, OR A RECOGNIZED STANDARD OFFI-
- 15 CIAL OR UNOFFICIAL CODE by reference -thereto in an adopting
- 16 ordinance and without publishing any such THE STATUTE, RULE, OR
- 17 code in full. : Provided, That said code is IF AN ORDINANCE
- 18 ADOPTS BY REFERENCE A STATUTE OF THIS STATE OR A RULE PROMULGATED
- 19 BY AN AGENCY OF THIS STATE, THE ORDINANCE MAY INCORPORATE FUTURE
- 20 AMENDMENTS OR REVISIONS OF THE STATUTE OR RULE BY EXPLICITLY PRO-
- 21 VIDING THAT FUTURE AMENDMENTS OR REVISIONS ARE INCORPORATED BY
- 22 REFERENCE WHEN, OR A SPECIFIED PERIOD OF TIME AFTER, THEY TAKE
- 23 EFFECT IN THIS STATE. THE STATUTE, RULE, OR CODE SHALL BE
- 24 clearly identified in -said THE ordinance, and -that A STATE-
- 25 MENT OF the purpose of -said THE STATUTE, RULE, OR code shall be
- 26 published with the adopting ordinance. and that printed PRINTED
- 27 copies thereof are OF THE STATUTE, RULE, OR CODE SHALL BE kept

1 in the office of the city clerk, available for inspection by and 2 distribution to the public. at all times, and that the THE 3 NEWSPAPER publication OF THE ORDINANCE shall contain a notice to 4 the effect STATING that a complete copy of said THE STATUTE, 5 RULE, OR code is available for INSPECTION BY AND DISTRIBUTION TO 6 THE public use and inspection at the office of the city clerk.
