



# HOUSE BILL No. 5464

December 6, 1995, Introduced by Rep. McNutt and referred to the Committee on Insurance.

A bill to amend section 3101a of Act No. 218 of the Public Acts of 1956, entitled as amended  
"The insurance code of 1956,"  
as added by Act No. 461 of the Public Acts of 1980, being section 500.3101a of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Section 3101a of Act No. 218 of the Public Acts  
2 of 1956, as added by Act No. 461 of the Public Acts of 1980,  
3 being section 500.3101a of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended  
4 to read as follows:

5 Sec. 3101a. (1) An insurer ~~, in conjunction with the issu-~~  
6 ~~ance of~~ THAT ISSUES an automobile insurance policy, as defined  
7 in section 3303, shall provide 2 certificates of insurance to  
8 each policyholder. The insurer shall mark 1 of the certificates  
9 as the secretary of state's copy, which copy shall be filed with

1 the secretary of state by the policyholder upon application for a  
2 vehicle registration. The secretary of state shall ~~not~~ main-  
3 tain the certificate of insurance received under this subsection  
4 on file. AN INSURER SHALL NOTIFY THE SECRETARY OF STATE AND THE  
5 LOCAL POLICE AGENCY OR COUNTY SHERIFF, AS APPLICABLE, IF A POLICY  
6 EXPIRES WITHOUT BEING RENEWED, IS TERMINATED, OR IF A POLICY-  
7 HOLDER CANCELS HIS OR HER AUTOMOBILE INSURANCE POLICY. THE  
8 NOTICE OF EXPIRATION, TERMINATION, OR CANCELLATION SHALL CONTAIN  
9 ALL OF THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

10 (A) THE VEHICLE IDENTIFICATION NUMBER.

11 (B) THE NAME AND ADDRESS OF THE INSURER.

12 (C) THE INSURANCE POLICY NUMBER.

13 (D) THE TIME AND DATE OF EXPIRATION, TERMINATION, OR  
14 CANCELLATION.

15 (2) A person who FAILS TO SUPPLY INFORMATION TO THE SECRE-  
16 TARY OF STATE OR THE LOCAL POLICE AGENCY OR COUNTY SHERIFF OR WHO  
17 supplies false information to the secretary of state under this  
18 section or who issues or uses an invalid certificate of insurance  
19 is guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by imprisonment for not  
20 more than 1 year, or a fine of not more than \$1,000.00, or both.

21 Section 2. This amendatory act shall not take effect unless  
22 Senate Bill No. \_\_\_\_\_ or House Bill No. 5465 (request  
23 no. 04179'95) of the 88th Legislature is enacted into law.
