



HOUSE BILL No. 5510

January 16, 1996, Introduced by Reps. Law, Llewellyn, Voorhees and Hill and referred to the Committee on Insurance.

A bill to amend section 3109a of Act No. 218 of the Public Acts of 1956, entitled as amended

"The insurance code of 1956,"

being section 500.3109a of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Section 3109a of Act No. 218 of the Public Acts
2 of 1956, being section 500.3109a of the Michigan Compiled Laws,
3 is amended to read as follows:

4 Sec. 3109a. An insurer providing personal protection insur-
5 ance benefits shall offer, at appropriately reduced premium
6 rates, deductibles and exclusions reasonably related to other
7 health and accident coverage on the insured OR OTHER PERSON ENTI-
8 TLED TO PERSONAL PROTECTION INSURANCE BENEFITS UNDER THE POLICY.

9 The deductibles and exclusions required to be offered by this
10 section shall be subject to prior approval by the commissioner

1 and shall apply ~~only~~ to benefits payable to ~~the~~ ANY person
2 ~~named in~~ ENTITLED TO BENEFITS UNDER the policy, ~~the spouse of~~
3 ~~the insured and any relative of either domiciled in the same~~
4 ~~household~~ INCLUDING BENEFITS PAYABLE TO A PERSON PURSUANT TO
5 SECTIONS 3111, 3114, AND 3115. HOWEVER, THE DEDUCTIBLES AND
6 EXCLUSIONS SHALL NOT APPLY TO ANY PERSON ENTITLED TO PERSONAL
7 PROTECTION INSURANCE BENEFITS UNDER THE POLICY, OTHER THAN THE
8 NAMED INSURED OR ANY RELATIVE OF THE NAMED INSURED RESIDING WITH
9 THE NAMED INSURED, WHO IS NOT COVERED BY OTHER HEALTH OR ACCIDENT
10 COVERAGE.
