



HOUSE BILL No. 5677

March 13, 1996, Introduced by Reps. Voorhees, DeLange, Hammerstrom, Hill, Dalman, Jaye, Goschka and Bodem and referred to the Committee on Insurance.

A bill to amend Act No. 218 of the Public Acts of 1956,
entitled as amended
"The insurance code of 1956,"
as amended, being sections 500.100 to 500.8302 of the Michigan
Compiled Laws, by adding section 4505.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Act No. 218 of the Public Acts of 1956, as
2 amended, being sections 500.100 to 500.8302 of the Michigan
3 Compiled Laws, is amended by adding section 4505 to read as
4 follows:

5 SEC. 4505. EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 1997, AN INSURER SHALL
6 INCLUDE IN NOT LESS THAN 12-POINT BOLDFACED TYPE ON THE LAST PAGE
7 ABOVE THE SIGNATURE BOX OF ALL INSURANCE POLICIES AND THE INITIAL
8 CLAIM FORM THE FOLLOWING STATEMENT: "ANY PERSON WHO MAKES OR
9 CAUSES TO BE MADE ANY KNOWINGLY FALSE AND MATERIAL ORAL OR

1 WRITTEN STATEMENT OR REPRESENTATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF OBTAINING
2 OR DENYING [INSURANCE OR HEALTH] BENEFITS OR PAYMENTS IS GUILTY
3 OF A FELONY.".
