



HOUSE BILL No. 5756

April 17, 1996, Introduced by Reps. Perricone, Walberg, Goschka, Cropsey, McManus, Horton, Law and Jellema and referred to the Committee on Tax Policy.

A bill to amend Act No. 281 of the Public Acts of 1967, entitled "Income tax act of 1967," as amended, being sections 206.1 to 206.532 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, by adding section 316.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Act No. 281 of the Public Acts of 1967, as
2 amended, being sections 206.1 to 206.532 of the Michigan Compiled
3 Laws, is amended by adding section 316 to read as follows:

4 SEC. 316. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL CONDUCT A STUDY ON THE COST
5 EFFECTIVENESS OF A TELEPHONE FILING PROGRAM FOR ANNUAL RETURNS
6 REQUIRED BY THIS ACT AND REPORT THE RESULTS OF THE STUDY TO THE
7 HOUSE TAX POLICY COMMITTEE AND SENATE FINANCE COMMITTEE BY JULY
8 1, 1997. IF THE STUDY DETERMINES THAT A TELEPHONE FILING PROGRAM
9 IS COST EFFECTIVE AND WOULD RESULT IN FINANCIAL SAVINGS TO THE

1 STATE, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL IMPLEMENT A TELEPHONE FILING PROGRAM
2 THAT TAXPAYERS MAY USE FOR ANNUAL RETURNS FILED UNDER THIS ACT
3 FOR THE 1999 TAX YEAR AND EACH TAX YEAR AFTER 1999.
