A bill to amend sections 2, 4, and 18 of Act No. 90 of the Public Acts of 1978, entitled
"Youth employment standards act,"
section 4 as amended by Act No. 71 of the Public Acts of 1987,
being sections 409.102, 409.104, and 409.118 of the Michigan
Compiled Laws.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Section 1. Sections 2, 4, and 118 of Act No. 90 of the
- 2 Public Acts of 1978, section 4 as amended by Act No. 71 of the
- 3 Public Acts of 1987, being sections 409.102, 409.104, and 409.118
- 4 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, are amended to read as follows:
- 5 Sec. 2. As used in this act:
  - (a) "Employ" means engage, permit, or allow to work.
- 7 (b) "Employer" means a person, firm, or corporation which
- 8 THAT employs a minor, and includes the state or a political

- 1 subdivision of the state, an agency or instrumentality of the
- 2 state, and an agent of an employer.
- 3 (c) "Issuing officer" means a superintendent THE CHIEF
- 4 ADMINISTRATOR of a school district, or intermediate school
- 5 district, PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMY, OR NONPUBLIC SCHOOL, or a person
- 6 whom the superintendent authorizes AUTHORIZED BY THAT CHIEF
- 7 ADMINISTRATOR in writing to act on HIS OR HER behalf. of the

- 9 (d) "Minor" means a person under 18 years of age.
- (e) "Rule" means a rule promulgated pursuant to THE ADMINIS-
- 11 TRATIVE PROCEDURES ACT OF 1969, Act No. 306 of the Public Acts
- 12 of 1969, as amended, being sections 24.201 to -24.315 24.328
- 13 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.
- 14 Sec. 4. (1) Except as provided in subsection (3), a minor
- 15 shall not be employed in an occupation regulated by this act
- 16 until the person proposing to employ the minor procures from the
- 17 minor and keeps on file at the place of employment a copy of the
- 18 work permit or a temporary permit. The work permit shall be
- 19 issued by the issuing officer of the school district, -or inter-
- 20 mediate school district, in PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMY, OR NONPUBLIC
- 21 SCHOOL AT which the minor -resides IS ENROLLED, and a copy of
- 22 the work permit shall be placed in the minor's permanent school
- 23 file for as long as the minor is employed. A temporary permit
- 24 shall be valid for 10 days from the date of issue. A work permit
- 25 may be issued by the school district in which the minor's place
- 26 of employment is located, OR BY THE PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMY OR

- 1 NONPUBLIC SCHOOL NEAREST THAT PLACE OF EMPLOYMENT. An issuing
- 2 officer may administer oaths in relation to work permits.
- 3 (2) Immediately after the termination of the minor's employ-
- 4 ment, the employer shall return the permit to the issuing
- 5 officer.
- 6 (3) The work permit requirement of subsection (1) does not
- 7 apply to a minor 13 years of age or older who is employed in
- 8 farming operations involving detasseling, roguing, hoeing, or any
- 9 similar act involved in the production of seed. This exception
- 10 applies only when a minor is employed during school vacation per-
- 11 iods or when the minor is not regularly enrolled in school. The
- 12 work permit exception provided in this subsection does not pro-
- 13 vide an exemption from any other provision of this act. An
- 14 employer shall keep on file at the place of employment evidence
- 15 of the age of any minor employed under this work permit
- 16 exception. Evidence of the age of the minor shall be established
- 17 as provided in section 5(b).
- 18 Sec. 18. This act -shall- DOES not apply to or prohibit
- 19 the employment of a student minor 14 years of age or older by an
- 20 employer if a written agreement or contract is entered into
- 21 between the employer and the board of education GOVERNING BODY
- 22 of the school district, in PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMY, OR NONPUBLIC
- 23 SCHOOL AT which the minor is enrolled. The employment shall not
- 24 be in violation of a federal statute or regulation and a signed
- 25 copy of the agreement shall be on file in the place of employment
- 26 before the minor begins employment.
