

## **HOUSE BILL No. 5846**

May 1, 1996, Introduced by Rep. Munsell and referred to the Committee on Tax Policy.

A bill to amend section 12 of Act No. 327 of the Public Acts of 1993, entitled

"Tobacco products tax act,"

being section 205.432 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Section 1. Section 12 of Act No. 327 of the Public Acts of
- 2 1993, being section 205.432 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is
- 3 amended to read as follows:
- 4 Sec. 12. (1) The proceeds derived from the payment of
- 5 taxes, fees, and penalties provided for under this act and the
- 6 license fees received by the department shall be deposited with
- 7 the state treasurer and disbursed only as provided in this
- 8 section.
- (2) The proceeds of the tax imposed under section 7(1)(a)
- 10 shall be DISBURSED AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 (A) 94% SHALL BE credited to the state school aid fund
  2 established by section 11 of article IX of the state constitution
  3 of 1963.
- 4 (B) 6% SHALL BE DEPOSITED IN THE HEALTHY MICHIGAN FUND.
- 5 (3) If the sales tax is levied at a rate of 4% under the
- 6 general sales tax act, Act No. 167 of the Public Acts of 1933,
- 7 the tax imposed on cigarettes pursuant to section 7(1)(b) shall
- 8 be disbursed as follows:
- 9 (a) The proceeds of 1.5 mills shall be credited to the
- 10 health and safety fund created in the health and safety fund act,
- 11 Act No. 264 of the Public Acts of 1987, being sections 141.471 to
- 12 141.479 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.
- 13 (b) The proceeds of 9.5 mills shall be credited to the gen
- 14 cral fund of this state.
- 15 (c) The proceeds of 8.5 mills shall be credited to the state
- 16 school aid fund established by section 11 of article IX of the
- 17 state constitution of 1963.
- 18 (d) The proceeds of .5 mills shall be distributed to city,
- 19 district, and county health departments created pursuant to
- 20 sections 24+3, 2415, and 2421 of the public health code, Act
- 21 No. 368 of the Public Acts of 1978, being sections 333.2413,
- 22 333.2415, and 333.2421 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, on a per
- 23 capita basis according to the most recent federal decennial
- 24 census. The distribution under this subdivision shall be used
- 25 only for public health prevention programs and services. This
- 26 distribution is in addition to and is not intended as a

- 1 replacement for any other state payments to these local health
  2 departments.
- 3 (3) (4) If the sales tax is levied at a rate of 6% under
- 4 the general sales tax act, Act No. 167 of the Public Acts of
- 5 1933, being sections 205.51 to 205.78 of the Michigan Compiled
- 6 Laws, THE PROCEEDS OF the tax imposed on cigarettes pursuant to
- 7 section  $\frac{-7(1)(c)}{}$  7(1)(B) AND THE PROCEEDS OF TAX IMPOSED PURSU-
- 8 ANT TO SECTION 7(4) shall be disbursed as follows:
- 9 (a) -4%- BEGINNING MAY 1, 1994, 5.3% of the proceeds shall
- 10 be credited to the health and safety fund created in the health
- 11 and safety fund act, Act No. 264 of the Public Acts of 1987,
- 12 being sections 141.471 to 141.479 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.
- (b) 25.3% of the proceeds shall be credited to the general
- 14 fund of this state.
- (c) 63.4% of the proceeds shall be credited to the state
- 16 school aid fund established by section 11 of article IX of the
- 17 state constitution of 1963.
- (d) 1.3% of the proceeds shall be distributed to city, dis
- 19 trict, and county health departments created pursuant to
- 20 sections 2413, 2415, and 2421 of the public health code, Act
- 21 No. 368 of the Public Acts of 1978, being sections 333.2413,
- 22 333.2415, and 333.2421 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, on a per
- 23 capita basis according to the most recent federal decennial
- 24 census. The distribution under this subdivision shall be used
- 25 only for public health prevention programs and services. This
- 26 distribution is in addition to and is not intended as a

- 1 replacement for any other state payments to these local health
- 2 departments.
- 3 (D) (e) 6% of the proceeds shall be dedicated to improv-
- 4 ing the health care of the residents of this state DEPOSITED IN
- 5 THE HEALTHY MICHIGAN FUND.
- 6 (4) -(5) The proceeds of the fees and penalties provided
- 7 for in this act shall be used for the administration of this
- 8 act.
