

## **HOUSE BILL No. 5848**

May 2, 1996, Introduced by Reps. Whyman, Hammerstrom, Green and Bryant and referred to the Committee on Tax Policy.

A bill to amend section 1211c of Act No. 451 of the Public Acts of 1976, entitled as amended

"The revised school code,"

as amended by Act No. 344 of the Public Acts of 1994, being section 380.1211c of the Michigan Compiled Laws; and to repeal acts and parts of acts.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Section 1. Section 1211c of Act No. 451 of the Public Acts
- 2 of 1976, as amended by Act No. 344 of the Public Acts of 1994,
- 3 being section 380.1211c of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended
- 4 to read as follows:
- 5 Sec. 1211c. For 1994 through 1996, a A school district
- 6 may levy, in addition to the millage authorized under section
- 7 1211, not more than 3 additional mills for enhancing operating

- I revenue if approved by the school electors at an election held
- 2 after 1993. The question of levying mills authorized under this
- 3 section shall be presented to school electors as a separate ques-
- 4 tion and identified as being for enhancement of operating
- 5 revenue. A school district that is not a school district
- 6 described in section  $\frac{20(+2) \cdot \text{or}}{(+3)}$  20(9) OR (10) of the state
- 7 school aid act of 1979, being section 388.1620 of the Michigan
- 8 Compiled Laws, shall not levy any millage under this section that
- 9 was approved by the school electors after September 30, 1994,
- 10 unless the school district levies, for the same tax year, the
- 11 maximum number of mills under section 1211 that does not exceed
- 12 the limitations imposed by section 1211(3).
- 13 Section 2. Section 705 of Act No. 451 of the Public Acts of
- 14 1976, being section 380.705 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is
- 15 repealed.
