

## **HOUSE BILL No. 5895**

May 22, 1996, Introduced by Rep. Oxender and referred to the Committee on Appropriations.

A bill to make appropriations for the department of education and certain other purposes relating to education for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1997; to provide for the expenditure of the appropriations; and to provide for the disposition of fees and other income received by the state agency.
