



# HOUSE BILL No. 5927

June 6, 1996, Introduced by Rep. Ciaramitaro and referred to the Committee on Commerce.

A bill to require a consumer's signature on agreements to renew his or her liability under certain consumer contracts.

**THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:**

1       Sec. 1. As used in this act:

2       (a) "Consumer" means an individual who purchases a good or  
3 service primarily for the individual's personal, family, or  
4 household use.

5       (b) "Consumer contract" means an agreement obligating a con-  
6 sumer to accept and pay for a good or service that is purchased  
7 primarily for the consumer's personal, family, or household use.

8       Sec. 2. An agreement to renew a consumer contract is void  
9 unless the agreement is both of the following:

10       (a) In a writing that specifies the contract renewal period  
11 and terms.

1 (b) Signed by the consumer at the beginning of each renewal  
2 period.
