



# HOUSE BILL No. 5958

June 7, 1996, Introduced by Rep. Jaye and referred to the Committee on Regulatory Affairs.

A bill to amend Act No. 239 of the Public Acts of 1972, entitled as amended

"McCauley-Traxler-Law-Bowman-McNeely lottery act,"

as amended, being sections 432.1 to 432.47 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, by adding section 32a.

**THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:**

1 Section 1. Act No. 239 of the Public Acts of 1972, as  
2 amended, being sections 432.1 to 432.47 of the Michigan Compiled  
3 Laws, is amended by adding section 32a to read as follows:

4 SEC. 32A. (1) IF THE BUREAU IS PRESENTED WITH VALID PROOF  
5 OF A JUDGMENT AGAINST A PRIZEWINNER DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (2),  
6 THE BUREAU SHALL FIRST APPLY THE AMOUNT OF THE PRIZE TO SATISFY  
7 THE JUDGMENT AND SHALL APPLY THE EXCESS, IF ANY, TO THE  
8 PRIZEWINNER.

1           (2) THIS SECTION ONLY APPLIES TO A PRIZEWINNER WHO IS A  
2 CONVICTED FELON, AGAINST WHOM A JUDGMENT HAS BEEN AWARDED IN A  
3 CIVIL ACTION FOR DAMAGES SUSTAINED DURING THE COMMISSION OF THE  
4 CRIME FOR WHICH THE PRIZEWINNER WAS CONVICTED.
