



# HOUSE BILL No. 5985

July 3, 1996, Introduced by Rep. Randall and referred to the Committee on House Oversight and Ethics.

A bill to amend section 298 of Act No. 431 of the Public Acts of 1984, entitled as amended "The management and budget act," being section 18.1298 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

**THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:**

1 Section 1. Section 298 of Act No. 431 of the Public Acts of  
2 1984, being section 18.1298 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is  
3 amended to read as follows:

4 Sec. 298. (1) The Michigan capitol park commission is cre-  
5 ated within the department. The Michigan capitol park commission  
6 shall exercise its prescribed statutory powers, duties, and func-  
7 tions as if it was transferred to the department under a type I  
8 transfer as described in section 3 of the executive organization  
9 act of 1965, Act No. 380 of the Public Acts of 1965, being  
10 section 16.103 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

1 (2) The Michigan capitol park commission consists of ~~7~~  
2 9 members appointed by the governor with the advice and consent  
3 of the senate. The governor shall appoint as ~~3~~ 5 of the ~~7~~ 9  
4 members THE DIRECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES, EX  
5 OFFICIO, THE DIRECTOR OF THE STATE TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT, EX  
6 OFFICIO, 1 individual recommended by the mayor of the city of  
7 Lansing, 1 individual recommended by the majority leader of the  
8 senate, and 1 individual recommended by the speaker of the house  
9 of representatives.

10 (3) Members of the Michigan capitol park commission OTHER  
11 THAN EX OFFICIO MEMBERS shall serve for terms of 4 years. ~~7~~  
12 ~~except~~ HOWEVER, of the members first appointed, 1 shall be  
13 appointed for a term of 1 year, 2 shall be appointed for a term  
14 of 2 years, 2 shall be appointed for a term of 3 years, and 2  
15 shall be appointed for a term of 4 years. Vacancies shall be  
16 filled by the governor in the same manner as the original  
17 appointment for the balance of the unexpired term. A member of  
18 the Michigan capitol park commission shall not receive compensa-  
19 tion for services as a commissioner, but each commissioner shall  
20 receive reimbursement for actual expenses incurred in connection  
21 with the duties of the office.

22 (4) The Michigan capitol park commission shall annually  
23 elect a chairperson, vice-chairperson, and ~~a~~ secretary.
