

HOUSE BILL No. 5998

July 3, 1996, Introduced by Reps. Gire, LaForge, Schroer and Scott and referred to the Committee on Judiciary and Civil Rights.

A bill to amend sections 243a, 243b, 243c, and 243d of Act No. 328 of the Public Acts of 1931, entitled as amended "The Michigan penal code,"

sections 243a and 243d as amended by Act No. 422 of the Public Acts of 1980, being sections 750.243a, 750.243b, 750.243c, and 750.243d of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Section 1. Sections 243a, 243b, 243c, and 243d of Act
- 2 No. 328 of the Public Acts of 1931, sections 243a and 243d as
- 3 amended by Act No. 422 of the Public Acts of 1980, being
- 4 sections 750.243a, 750.243b, 750.243c, and 750.243d of the
- 5 Michigan Compiled Laws, are amended to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 243a. (1) As used in this chapter:
- 7 (a) "Fireworks" means a device made from explosive or
- 8 flammable compositions used primarily for the purpose of

- 1 producing a visible display or audible effect, or both, by
- 2 combustion, deflagration, or detonation. Fireworks includes
- 3 class B fireworks and class C fireworks.
- 4 (b) "Class B fireworks" means toy torpedoes, railway torpe
- 5 does, firecrackers or salutes that do not qualify as class C
- 6 fireworks, exhibition display pieces, aeroplane flares, illumi-
- 7 nating projectiles, incendiary projectiles, incendiary grenades,
- 8 smoke projectiles or bombs containing expelling charges but with
- 9 out bursting charges, flash powders in inner units not exceeding
- 10 2 ounces each, flash sheets in interior packages, flash powder or
- 11 spreader cartridges containing not more than 72 grains of flash
- 12 powder each, and other similar devices.
- (c) "Class C fireworks" means toy smoke devices, toy caps
- 14 containing not more than .25 grains of explosive mixture, toy
- 15 propellant devices, cigarette loads, trick matches, trick noise
- 16 makers, smoke candles, smoke pots, smoke grenades, smoke signals,
- 17 hand signal devices, Very signal cartridges, sparklers, explosive
- 18 auto alarms, and other similar devices.
- (A) "CLASS B FIREWORKS" MEANS 1 OR MORE OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 20 (i) A TOY TORPEDO, RAILWAY TORPEDO, FIRECRACKER, OR SALUTE
- 21 THAT DOES NOT QUALIFY AS CLASS C FIREWORKS.
- 22 (ii) AN EXHIBITION DISPLAY PIECE, AEROPLANE FLARE, ILLUMI-
- 23 NATING PROJECTILE, INCENDIARY PROJECTILE, INCENDIARY GRENADE,
- 24 SMOKE PROJECTILE, OR BOMB THAT CONTAINS AN EXPELLING CHARGE BUT
- 25 THAT DOES NOT CONTAIN A BURSTING CHARGE.
- 26 (iii) FLASH POWDER IN AN INNER UNIT THAT DOES NOT EXCEED 2
- 27 OUNCES PER UNIT.

- (iv) A FLASH SHEET IN AN INTERIOR PACKAGE.
- v) A FLASH POWDER OR SPREADER CARTRIDGE CONTAINING NOT MORE
- 3 THAN 72 GRAINS OF FLASH POWDER.
- 4 (vi) ANY OTHER DEVICE SUBSTANTIALLY SIMILAR TO A DEVICE
- 5 DESCRIBED IN SUBPARAGRAPHS (i) TO (v).
- 6 (B) "CLASS C FIREWORKS" MEANS 1 OR MORE OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 7 (i) A TOY SMOKE DEVICE.
- 8 (ii) A TOY CAP CONTAINING NOT MORE THAN .25 GRAINS OF EXPLO-
- 9 SIVE MIXTURE.
- 10 (iii) A TOY PROPELLANT DEVICE.
- 11 (iv) A CIGARETTE LOAD.
- 12 (v) A TRICK MATCH.
- 13 (yi) A TRICK NOISE MAKER.
- (vii) A SMOKE CANDLE, SMOKE POT, SMOKE GRENADE, OR SMOKE
- 15 SIGNAL.
- 16 (viii) A HAND SIGNAL DEVICE.
- 17 (ix) A VERY SIGNAL CARTRIDGE.
- 18 (x) A SPARKLER.
- 19 (xi) AN EXPLOSIVE AUTO ALARM.
- 20 (xii) ANY OTHER DEVICE SUBSTANTIALLY SIMILAR TO A DEVICE
- 21 DESCRIBED IN SUBPARAGRAPHS (i) TO (xi).
- 22 (C) "FIREWORKS" MEANS A DEVICE MADE FROM AN EXPLOSIVE OR
- 23 FLAMMABLE COMPOSITION THAT IS USED PRIMARILY TO PRODUCE A VISIBLE
- 24 DISPLAY OR AUDIBLE EFFECT, OR BOTH, BY COMBUSTION, DEFLAGRATION,
- 25 OR DETONATION. FIREWORKS INCLUDES CLASS B FIREWORKS AND CLASS C
- 26 FIREWORKS.

- 1 (D) "PERSON" MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL, PARTNERSHIP, CORPORATION,
- 2 ASSOCIATION, GOVERNMENTAL ENTITY, OR OTHER LEGAL ENTITY.
- 3 (2) Except as provided in subsection (3) and sections 243b,
- 4 243c, and 243d, a person -, firm, partnership, or corporation
- 5 shall not offer for sale, expose for sale, sell at retail, keep
- 6 with intent to sell at retail, possess, give, furnish, transport,
- 7 use, explode, or cause to explode any of the following:
- 8 (a) A blank cartridge, blank cartridge pistol, toy cannon,
- 9 toy cane, or toy gun in which explosives are used.
- 10 (b) An unmanned balloon which THAT requires fire under-
- II neath to propel it and THAT is not moored to the ground while
- 12 aloft.
- (c) Pirecrackers, torpedoes, skyrockets, roman candles,
- 14 daygo bombs, bottle rockets, whistling chasers, rockets on
- 15 sticks, A FIRECRACKER, TORPEDO, SKYROCKET, ROMAN CANDLE, DAYGO
- 16 BOMB, BOTTLE ROCKET, WHISTLING CHASER, ROCKET ON A STICK, or
- 17 other fireworks FIREWORK of like SUBSTANTIALLY SIMILAR
- 18 construction.
- (d) Fireworks containing an explosive or -inflammable-
- 20 FLAMMABLE compound. or a
- 21 (E) A tablet or other device commonly used and sold as fire-
- 22 works -containing nitrates, fulminates, chlorates, oxalates,
- 23 sulphides THAT CONTAINS A NITRATE, FULMINATE, CHLORATE, OXALATE,
- 24 SULPHIDE of lead, barium, antimony, arsenic, mercury, nitroglyc-
- 25 erine, phosphorus, or a compound containing these or ANY other
- 26 modern explosives.

- (3) A permit is not required for ANY OF the following:
- 2 (a) Flat paper caps containing not more than .25 of a grain
- 3 of explosive content per cap, in -packages A PACKAGE labeled to
- 4 indicate the maximum explosive content per cap.
- 5 (b) Toy pistols A TOY PISTOL, toy cannons CANNON, toy
- 6 -canes CANE, toy trick noise -makers MAKER, -and OR toy -guns
- 7 GUN of a type approved by the director of the department of state
- 8 police in which paper caps as described in subdivision (a) are
- 9 used and which are so THAT IS constructed SO that the A hand
- 10 cannot come in contact with the cap when THE CAP IS in place for
- II the explosion and which are THAT IS not designed to break apart
- 12 or be separated so as to form a missile by the explosion.
- (c) Sparklers A SPARKLER containing not more than .0125
- 14 pounds of burning portion per sparkler MATERIAL.
- (d) Flitter sparklers A FLITTER SPARKLER in A paper
- 16 -tubes TUBE not exceeding 1/8 inch in diameter, A cone
- 17 -fountains FOUNTAIN, and OR A cylinder -fountains FOUNTAIN.
- 18 (e) Toy snakes A TOY SNAKE THAT DOES not containing
- 19 CONTAIN mercury, if THE TOY SNAKE IS packed in A cardboard
- 20 -boxes BOX with not more than 12 pieces per box for retail sale
- 21 and if the manufacturer's name and the quantity OF TOY SNAKES
- 22 contained in each box are printed on the box. -; and toy smoke
- 23 devices.
- 24 (F) A TOY SMOKE DEVICE.
- 25 (G) (f) Possession, transportation, sale, or use of
- 26 POSSESSING, TRANSPORTING, SELLING, OR USING ANY OF THE
- 27 FOLLOWING:

- I (i) A signal -flares FLARE of a type approved by the
- 2 director of the department of state police. —
- 3 (ii) A blank cartridges CARTRIDGE or blank cartridge
- 4 -pistols PISTOL specifically DESIGNED for -a USE IN ANY OF THE
- 5 FOLLOWING:
- 6 (A) A show or theater. The training
- 7 (B) TRAINING or exhibiting -of dogs. for signal
- 8 (C) SIGNAL purposes in athletic sports. The for use by
- 9 military
- 10 (D) MILITARY organizations. -, and all items
- (iii) ANY DEVICE described in subsection (2) THAT IS used OR
- 12 INTENDED TO BE USED by -railroads A RAILROAD for emergency
- 13 signal purposes.
- (H) (g) The sale of fireworks, provided they are to be
- 15 shipped directly out of FIREWORKS THAT ARE SOLD IN THIS STATE
- 16 BUT ARE DELIVERED BY THE SELLER DIRECTLY TO THE BUYER WHO IS NOT
- 17 PHYSICALLY LOCATED IN THIS state -pursuant to- AT THE TIME THE
- 18 DELIVERY IS MADE, AND THE DELIVERY IS MADE IN COMPLIANCE WITH
- 19 regulations of the United States department of transportation
- 20 covering the transportation of explosives and other dangerous
- 21 articles by motor, rail, -and OR water.
- Sec. 243b. (1) The council or commission of a city or vil-
- 23 lage or the township board of a township, upon application in
- 24 writing, on -forms A FORM provided by the director of the
- 25 department of state police, may grant a permit -for the TO AN
- 26 APPLICANT TO use -of- fireworks WITHIN THE POLITICAL JURISDICTION
- 27 OF THAT CITY, VILLAGE, OR TOWNSHIP THAT ARE otherwise prohibited

- 2 manufactured for outdoor pest control or agricultural purposes,
- 3 or for public display by -municipalities THE APPLICANT ON BEHALF

- 6 GROUP of individuals approved by the city, village, or township

- 10 After IF a permit has been granted, sales, possession, or

- 13 purposes ANY PURPOSE described in the permit. only made be

- 16 to a person under the age of AN INDIVIDUAL LESS THAN 18 years
- 17 OF AGE.
- (2) The council or commission of a city or village or the
- 19 township board of a township, upon application in writing, may
- 20 grant a permit, on -forms A FORM provided by the director of the
- 21 department of state police, to a resident wholesale dealer or
- 22 jobber to have FIREWORKS OTHERWISE PROHIBITED UNDER SECTION 243A
- 23 in his OR HER possession within the political jurisdiction -
- 24 fireworks otherwise prohibited by section 243a, for sale only to
- 25 holders of permits as provided in this section. A permit granted
- 26 under this subsection is not transferable, -nor AND shall -a

- I permit NOT be issued to a person under the age of AN
- 2 INDIVIDUAL LESS THAN 18 years OF AGE.
- 3 (3) Before a permit for a pyrotechnic display is issued, the
- 4 person, firm, or corporation making application -therefor FOR
- 5 THE PERMIT shall furnish proof of financial responsibility by a
- 6 bond or insurance in an amount -deemed CONSIDERED necessary by
- 7 the local governing authority to satisfy ALL claims for damages
- 8 to property or personal injuries arising out of an act or omis-
- 9 sion on the part of the person -, firm, or corporation, or an
- 10 agent or employee -thereof, OF THAT PERSON. THE BOND OR INSUR-
- 11 ANCE SHALL BE in the amount, character, and form the local
- 12 authority determines IS necessary for the protection of TO
- 13 PROTECT the public.
- 14 (4) A permit shall not be issued under this act to a nonres-
- 15 ident person -, firm, or corporation for TO conduct of a pyro-
- 16 technic display in this state until the person -, firm, or
- 17 corporation has appointed in writing a resident member of the
- 18 bar of this state STATE BAR OF MICHIGAN or a resident agent
- 19 OF THIS STATE to be his OR HER legal representative upon whom all
- 20 process in an action or proceeding against him OR HER may be
- 21 served.
- 22 (5) The local governing authority shall rule on CONSIDER
- 23 the competency and qualifications of -operators A PROSPECTIVE
- 24 OPERATOR of A pyrotechnic displays, as the operator has DISPLAY
- 25 BASED UPON THE INFORMATION furnished in his OR HER application
- 26 form -, and on BEFORE ISSUING A PERMIT UNDER THIS SECTION.

- 2 and safety aspects of the -displays- DISPLAY before -granting

- 4 Sec. 243c. Transportation of fireworks FIREWORKS SHALL BE
- 5 TRANSPORTED intrastate -shall be made only IN COMPLIANCE with
- 6 the permits provided for in A PERMIT ISSUED UNDER this act and
- 7 as follows:
- 8 (a) In -accordance COMPLIANCE with United States department
- 9 of transportation regulations for -transportation of-
- 10 TRANSPORTING explosives and other dangerous articles by motor,
- 11 rail, -and OR water, including, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, specifica-
- 12 tions for shipping containers.
- (b) In A nonpassenger carrying vehicles VEHICLE, in THE
- 14 charge of a competent driver -not less than WHO IS 18 years of
- 15 age OR OLDER, -which are THAT IS equipped with a 15-pound carbon
- 16 dioxide FIRE EXTINGUISHER or a 10-pound dry chemical fire extin-
- 17 quisher -- and in WHICH or near which smoking -shall be IS pro-
- 18 hibited while loading, unloading, or transporting fireworks.
- 19 Sec. 243d. The storage of fireworks at the site of a whole-
- 20 saler, dealer, or jobber, except for a retailer who has goods on
- 21 hand for sale to the public in a supervised display area, shall
- 22 be as follows:
- 23 (a) In a 1-story, noncombustible building without THAT
- 24 DOES NOT HAVE a basement, which building AND THAT is weather
- 25 resistant, well ventilated, and equipped with a strong door THAT
- 26 IS kept securely locked except when THE BUILDING IS open for
- 27 business.

1 (b) The location of the storage building shall be approved
2 by the local governing authority having jurisdiction. —, and THE
3 BUILDING shall be located not less than the following distances
4 from inhabited buildings, passenger railroads, and public high5 ways —according to—BASED UPON the number of pounds of fireworks
6 stored, rounded to the nearest pound:

- 1 STORING FIREWORKS or within 50 feet of a building -used for the
- 2 storage of STORING fireworks. A person shall not store combus-
- 3 tible materials within 50 feet of a building used for the stor-
- 4 age of STORING fireworks.
- 5 (d) The interior of a building used for the storage of
- 6 STORING fireworks shall be kept clean and free from debris and
- 7 empty containers. A person shall not use a building -used for
- 8 the storage of STORING fireworks for the storage of TO STORE
- 9 any metal -tools TOOL or any OTHER commodity other than
- 10 fireworks.
- (e) A person shall not provide EQUIP a building used for
- 12 the storage of TO STORE fireworks with heat or lights. Texcept
- 13 that if lights are necessary, THIS SUBDIVISION DOES NOT PROHIBIT
- 14 THE USE OF an electric safety flashlight or safety lantern -shall
- 15 be used IN THE BUILDING.
- (f) A building used for the storage of TO STORE fireworks
- 17 shall -bear lettering HAVE THE FOLLOWING WARNING on each side
- 18 and -top- ON THE ROOF in letters not less than 4 inches high: -
- 19 the words "explosives--keep fire away".
- 20 (g) A building used for the storage of STORING fireworks
- 21 shall be under the supervision of a competent person who
- 22 -shall be not less than IS 18 years of age OR OLDER.
- 23 (h) In addition to the requirements of subdivision (b),
- 24 salutes that do not qualify as class C fireworks -shall be ARE
- 25 considered to be hazardous material and shall be stored in
- 26 -accordance COMPLIANCE with rules for the storage STORING and
- 27 handling of hazardous material THAT ARE promulgated under

- 1 section 3c of Act No. 207 of the Public Acts of 1941, -as
- 2 amended, being section 29.3c of the Michigan Compiled Laws.
