

September 10, 1996, Introduced by Rep. Martinez and referred to the Committee on House Oversight and Ethics.

A bill to amend section 3 of Act No. 169 of the Public Acts of 1976, entitled as amended

"An act to regulate certain political activities by certain public employees; to prescribe the powers and duties of certain state agencies; and to provide penalties,"

being section 15.403 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Section 1. Section 3 of Act No. 169 of the Public Acts of
- 2 1976, being section 15.403 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is
- 3 amended to read as follows:
- 4 Sec. 3. (1) An employee of a political subdivision of the
- 5 state may DO 1 OR MORE OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 6 (a) Become a member of a political party committee formed or
- 7 authorized under the election laws of this state.
- 8 (b) Be a delegate to a state convention, or a district or
- 9 county convention held by a political party in this state.

- (c) Become a candidate for nomination and election to any
- 2 state elective office, or any district, county, city, village,
- 3 township, school district, or other local elective office without
- 4 first obtaining a leave of absence from his OR HER employment.
- 5 If the person becomes a candidate for elective office within the
- 6 unit of government or school district in which he is employed,
- 7 unless contrary to a collective bargaining agreement the employer
- 8 may require the person to request and take a leave of absence
- 9 without pay when he complies with the candidacy filing require
- 10 ments, or 60 days before any election relating to that position,
- II whichever date is closer to the election.
- (d) Engage in other political activities on behalf of a can-
- 13 didate or issue in connection with partisan or nonpartisan
- 14 elections.
- (2) However, a A public employee of a unit of local gov-
- 16 ernment or school district who is elected to an office within
- 17 that unit of local government or school district shall resign or
- 18 may be granted a leave of absence from his OR HER employment
- 19 during his OR HER elected term.
