

HOUSE BILL No. 6031

September 11, 1996, Introduced by Rep. Profit and referred to the Committee on Local Government.

A bill to amend the title and sections 1, 3, 4, 7, 8, and 11 of Act No. 206 of the Public Acts of 1957, entitled as amended

"An act to authorize 2 or more counties, cities, townships and incorporated villages, or any combination thereof, to incorporate an airport authority for the planning, promoting, acquiring, constructing, improving, enlarging, extending, owning, maintaining and operating the landing, navigational and building facilities necessary thereto of 1 or more community airports; to provide for changes in the membership therein; to authorize an authority or the counties, cities, townships and incorporated villages that form an authority to levy taxes for such purposes; to provide for the operation and maintenance and issuing notes therefor; and to authorize condemnation proceedings,"

sections 1, 3, 4, and 8 as amended by Act No. 312 of the Public Acts of 1982 and section 7 as amended by Act No. 182 of the Public Acts of 1983, being sections 259.621, 259.623, 259.624, 259.627, 259.628, and 259.631 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Section 1. The title and sections 1, 3, 4, 7, 8, and 11 of
- 2 Act No. 206 of the Public Acts of 1957, sections 1, 3, 4, and 8

- 5 TITLE
- An act to authorize 2 or more counties, cities, townships,
- 7 -and incorporated villages, UNIVERSITIES, COMMUNITY COLLEGES, or
- 8 any combination thereof, to incorporate an airport authority for
- 9 the planning, promoting, acquiring, constructing, improving,
- 10 enlarging, extending, owning, maintaining and operating the land-
- 11 ing, navigational and building facilities necessary thereto of 1
- 12 or more community airports; to provide for changes in the member-
- 13 ship therein; to authorize an authority or the counties, cities,
- 14 townships, -and incorporated villages, UNIVERSITIES, AND COMMU-
- 15 NITY COLLEGES that form an authority to levy taxes for such pur-
- 16 poses; to provide for the operation and maintenance and issuing
- 17 notes therefor; and to authorize condemnation proceedings.
- 18 Sec. 1. Any 2 or more counties, cities, incorporated vil
- 19 lages, or townships, or any combination thereof ELIGIBLE PUBLIC
- 20 ENTITIES, by resolution of their respective -legislative-
- 21 GOVERNING bodies, may join to form an airport authority for the
- 22 purpose of planning, promoting, acquiring, constructing, improv-
- 23 ing, enlarging, extending, owning, maintaining, and operating,
- 24 EITHER WITHIN OR OUTSIDE OF THEIR JURISDICTIONAL BOUNDARIES, the
- 25 NECESSARY landing, navigational, and building facilities
- 26 -necessary thereto, either within or without their limits, of 1
- 27 or more community airports. A site for the physical facilities

- 1 of the airport authority shall not be selected without the
- 2 approval of 2/3 of the total membership of the airport authority
- 3 board and shall be located within the boundaries of the airport
- 4 authority.
- 5 Sec. 3. (1) The resolution creating the airport authority
- 6 shall designate the -counties, cities, incorporated villages, and
- 7 townships ELIGIBLE PUBLIC ENTITIES to be included -therein IN
- 8 THE FORMATION OF THE AUTHORITY and shall set forth the fact that
- 9 a sum of money not to exceed 1 mill of their assessed valuation
- 10 as last equalized by the state may be requested and certified by
- 11 the airport authority board annually for the purpose of planning,
- 12 promoting, acquiring, constructing, improving, enlarging, extend-
- 13 ing, owning, maintaining, and operating the necessary landing,
- 14 navigational, and building facilities of 1 or more community
- 15 airports. The resolution also shall provide that the requested
- 16 money or any portion of the requested money may be pledged by the
- 17 governing body of the airport authority for the payment of reve-
- 18 nue bonds under THE REVENUE BOND ACT OF 1933, Act No. 94 of the
- 19 Public Acts of 1933, -as amended, being sections 141.101 to
- 20 -141.139 141.140 of the Michigan Compiled Laws. The authority
- 21 shall be -deemed CONSIDERED to be a charter authority within the
- 22 meaning of section 6 of article -9 IX of the state constitution
- 23 of 1963. The resolution may provide that the airport authority
- 24 shall become operative if a specified number of the proposed
- 25 number of members GOVERNING bodies approve it. The resolution
- 26 may Fix ESTABLISH a time within which the respective -local
- 27 units ELIGIBLE PUBLIC ENTITIES must act in order to be included

- 1 in the airport authority. The resolution may designate a date
- 2 for the appointed representatives to convene.
- 3 (2) Any -county, city, incorporated village, or township
- 4 ELIGIBLE PUBLIC ENTITY may subsequently become a member of any
- 5 airport authority formed under this act upon resolution adopted
- 6 by the governing body of the -municipality ELIGIBLE PUBLIC
- 7 ENTITY and acceptance by resolution adopted by majority vote of
- 8 the entire governing board of the airport authority. Any
- 9 -county, city, incorporated village, or township ELIGIBLE PUBLIC
- 10 ENTITY which is or becomes a member of an airport authority, upon
- 11 request and upon resolution of its governing body, duly accepted
- 12 by a 2/3 majority vote of the entire governing board of the air-
- 13 port authority, may be released from membership in the airport
- 14 authority. A county, city, incorporated village, or township
- 15 AN ELIGIBLE PUBLIC ENTITY may not be released from membership in
- 16 -any AN airport authority formed under this act until all out-
- 17 standing obligations of the airport authority that have been
- 18 incurred after the time of the admission to membership of the
- 19 county, city, incorporated village, or township ELIGIBLE PUBLIC
- 20 ENTITY and that part of prior obligations as may be agreed to by
- 21 the board and the governing body of the county, city, incorpo-
- 22 rated village, or township ELIGIBLE PUBLIC ENTITY have been
- 23 paid, or adequate provision has been made for the payment.
- 24 -thereof.
- 25 Sec. 4. (1) The legislative GOVERNING bodies of the
- 26 -counties, cities, incorporated villages, and townships ELIGIBLE
- 27 PUBLIC ENTITIES creating the airport authority may raise by an ad

- 1 valorem property tax, to be levied on the taxable property within
- 2 their respective jurisdictions, a sum of money to be used to
- 3 assist in the planning, promoting, acquiring, constructing,
- 4 improving, enlarging, extending, owning, maintaining, and operat-
- 5 ing the NECESSARY landing, navigational, and building facilities
- 6 -necessary thereto of the community airport authorized by this
- 7 act. The tax shall not exceed 1 mill on each dollar of the state
- 8 equalized valuation of each county, city, incorporated village,
- 9 or township ELIGIBLE PUBLIC ENTITY. In computing the total tax
- 10 to be levied, the assessed valuation of any unit of government
- 11 ELIGIBLE PUBLIC ENTITY joining the airport authority shall not be
- 12 used more than once.
- 13 (2) The ad valorem property tax authorized by this section
- 14 shall not be levied unless approved by the majority of the quali-
- 15 fied electors of the -member local unit ELIGIBLE PUBLIC ENTITY
- 16 voting thereon FOR THE AD VALOREM PROPERTY TAX. A tax approved
- 17 pursuant to this subsection may be levied until the -local unit-
- 18 ELIGIBLE PUBLIC ENTITY is released from membership in the author-
- 19 ity or until the authority is dissolved, whichever occurs first.
- 20 However, this subsection shall not be considered to prohibit the
- 21 use of revenues from ad valorem property tax levies of mills
- 22 within the member local unit's charter or statutory limitation to
- 23 pay an appropriation required by the airport authority.
- 24 (3) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION IN THIS ACT, A UNI-
- 25 VERSITY THAT PARTICIPATES IN THE CREATION OF AN AIRPORT AUTHORITY
- 26 IS EXEMPT FROM THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS ACT RELATED TO THE
- 27 LEVYING OF AN AD VALOREM PROPERTY TAX.

- 1 Sec. 7. (1) Not later than April 1 of each year the airport
 2 authority board shall prepare a budget containing an itemized
 3 statement of the estimated current expenses and the expenses for
 4 capital outlay, including the amount necessary to pay the princi5 pal and interest of any outstanding bonds or other obligations of
 6 the authority maturing during the ensuing fiscal year or which
 7 have previously matured and are unpaid, and an estimate of the
 8 estimated revenue of the airport authority from all sources for
 9 the ensuing fiscal year. Airport authorities consisting only
 10 of 2 or more counties shall have until September 1 of each year
 11 to prepare this budget. The board shall adopt -such- A budget as
 12 -shall be deemed IS CONSIDERED necessary and shall ascertain
 13 what appropriations are required from the several -counties,
 14 cities, townships, and villages- ELIGIBLE PUBLIC ENTITIES to meet
 15 their respective shares of the amount of the budget in excess of
- (2) In determining the fair and equitable share of each county, city, —and— township, AND COMMUNITY COLLEGE, the board shall establish the ratio that the state equalized valuation of each for the year in which the appropriation is required bears to the total state equalized valuation for the year in which the appropriation is required of all the counties, cities, —and—townships, AND COMMUNITY COLLEGES included in the airport author—ty and use the applicable ratio in determining the amount of appropriation required from a county, city, —or—township, OR COMMUNITY COLLEGE. Any village included in the airport authority shall appropriate its proportionate share of the amount

- 1 apportioned to the township in which it is located, and in
- 2 determining the division between the township and village, the
- 3 amount of their respective state equalized valuations for the
- 4 year the appropriation is required shall be used as the basis for
- 5 the determination. The board shall certify to each participating
- 6 county, city, township, -and village, AND COMMUNITY COLLEGE the
- 7 amount to be raised by them, and the respective counties, cities,
- 8 townships, -and villages, AND COMMUNITY COLLEGES shall include
- 9 such amounts in their next ensuing budgets and shall pay the
- 10 amounts so certified from any funds they have available or from
- 11 the proceeds of a tax which they are authorized to levy, in an
- 12 amount sufficient -therefor TO MEET THE AMOUNT, but not
- 13 exceeding 1 mill. Payment of sums so certified shall be due and
- 14 payable to the airport authority 120 days subsequent to the date
- 15 upon which local taxes become due and payable in counties,
- 16 cities, villages, -and townships, AND COMMUNITY COLLEGES partic-
- 17 ipating in the airport authority. Each county, city, township,
- 18 -and village, AND COMMUNITY COLLEGE shall be liable for the
- 19 amount so certified.
- 20 (3) The board shall also render to each participating
- 21 county, city, township, and village ELIGIBLE PUBLIC ENTITY, on
- 22 each July 1, during the operation of the airport a certified
- 23 report of the operation of the airport. Each report shall state
- 24 the condition of the finances, the amount of money expended, and
- 25 the money received from all sources. The board shall also file a
- 26 copy of the report with the department of treasury together with
- 27 any other information the department of treasury may require.

- 1 Within 30 days after the formation of any new airport authority,
- 2 and annually on July I thereafter, the airport authority board
- 3 shall file with the secretary of state a report as the secretary
- 4 of state may require, showing the date of formation, the names of
- 5 the member communities, and any other information as the report
- 6 may call for.
- 7 Sec. 8. For the purpose of acquiring, purchasing, con-
- 8 structing, improving, enlarging, or repairing such community air-
- 9 ports, the airport authority board may issue self-liquidating
- 10 bonds of the authority in accordance with THE REVENUE BOND ACT OF
- 11 1933, Act No. 94 of the Public Acts of 1933, as amended, being
- 12 sections 141.101 to -141.139 141.140 of the Michigan Compiled
- 13 Laws. The bonds shall not impose any liability upon the
- 14 -counties, cities, villages, and townships ELIGIBLE PUBLIC
- 15 ENTITIES included in the airport authority, other than on the
- 16 amounts -which THAT are assessed against the respective
- 17 -municipalities ELIGIBLE PUBLIC ENTITIES as provided for by this
- 18 act, which amounts or any portion -thereof OF THE AMOUNTS may be
- 19 pledged by the governing body of the airport authority for the
- 20 payment of the bonds for a period not exceeding 40 years. The
- 21 amount -herein required to be paid by any -municipality
- 22 ELIGIBLE PUBLIC ENTITY under the provisions of this act shall
- 23 be considered to be a part of the revenues of the airport author-
- 24 ity as that term is defined in section 3(f) of Act No. 94 of the
- 25 Public Acts of 1933, as amended, being section 141.103 of the
- 26 Michigan Compiled Laws. The bonds shall be sold for not less
- 27 than par and shall bear interest at a rate not in excess of the

1 maximum rate permitted under section 12 of Act No. 94 of the 2 Public Acts of 1933, as amended, being section 141.112 of the 3 Michigan Compiled Laws. If a petition for referendum is filed 4 with the secretary of the airport authority in accordance with 5 the provisions of section 33 of Act No. 94 of the Public Acts of 6 1933, as amended, being section 141.133 of the Michigan 7 Compiled Laws, the governing body of the airport authority shall 8 adopt a resolution establishing the date of the election, which 9 shall be not less than 60 days nor more than 90 days after the 10 adoption of the resolution. The secretary of the authority, 11 within 5 days after the adoption of the resolution, shall trans-12 mit a certified copy of the resolution to the governing body of 13 each member community AND COMMUNITY COLLEGE. The governing 14 bodies of the member communities AND COMMUNITY COLLEGES immedi-15 ately shall provide for an election in accordance with the reso-16 lution passed by the authority, in which the question of issuing 17 the bonds and pledging the authority's revenues, including all or 18 any part of the amounts assessed against the respective munici-19 palities AND COMMUNITY COLLEGES as provided for by this act, 20 shall be submitted. The ballots for use in the election shall be 21 provided by the authority and the election shall be conducted in 22 the respective communities AND COMMUNITY COLLEGES except that if 23 any part or all of a village belonging to an airport authority is 24 located in a township belonging to the same authority, the town-25 ship election shall include that part of the village located in 26 it and the village shall not be required to hold an election 27 except in that portion of the village not located in a township

- 1 belonging to the authority. The governing bodies of the member
- 2 communities AND COMMUNITY COLLEGES shall act as a board of can-
- 3 vassers and shall certify the results of the election to the air-
- 4 port authority board, within 5 days after the date of the elec-
- 5 tion, on forms provided by the airport authority. The airport
- 6 authority board shall compile and tabulate the vote as required
- 7 from the member communities AND COMMUNITY COLLEGES and certify
- 8 the result of the election by resolution upon the records of the
- 9 authority. A majority of the total valid votes cast at such an
- 10 election voting "yes" on the question submitted shall constitute
- 11 an approval of the issuance of the bonds.
- 12 Sec. 11. As used in this act: , "community
- 13 (A) "COMMUNITY airport" means any location, either on land
- 14 or water, which is used for the landing or take-off of aircraft,
- 15 which provides facilities for the shelter, supply, or care of
- 16 aircraft, or for receiving or discharging passengers or cargo,
- 17 and all appurtenant areas used or suitable for airport buildings
- 18 or other airport facilities, INCLUDING all appurtenant
- 19 rights-of-way and runway clear zones as designated by the civil
- 20 aeronautics authority. , whether heretofore or hereafter
- 21 established.
- 22 (B) "ELIGIBLE PUBLIC ENTITY" MEANS A COUNTY, CITY, VILLAGE,
- 23 TOWNSHIP, OR A STATE COLLEGE OR UNIVERSITY, OR ANY COMBINATION OF
- 24 THESE ENTITIES.
