A bill to amend Act No. 328 of the Public Acts of 1931,  
entitled as amended

"The Michigan penal code,"

as amended, being sections 750.1 to 750.568 of the Michigan  
Compiled Laws, by adding section 310a.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Act No. 328 of the Public Acts of 1931, as  
2 amended, being sections 750.1 to 750.568 of the Michigan Compiled  
3 Laws, is amended by adding section 310a to read as follows:

4 SEC. 310A. (1) EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION  
5 (2), THIS CHAPTER DOES NOT APPLY TO A BOWLING GAME CONDUCTED IN A  
6 BOWLING CENTER FOR WHICH THE VALUE OF EACH PRIZE DOES NOT EXCEED  
7 \$1,000.00, AND EACH WAGER DOES NOT EXCEED \$5.00. AS USED IN THIS  
8 SUBSECTION, "BOWLING GAME" INCLUDES, BUT IS NOT LIMITED TO, ANY  
9 OF THE FOLLOWING GAMES:

1 (A) MYSTERY GAME.

2 (B) STRIKE BALL.

3 (C) RED PIN.

4 (2) THE PRIZE AND WAGER LIMITATION IN SUBSECTION (1) SHALL  
5 BE ANNUALLY ADJUSTED WITH THE RATE OF INFLATION USING THE DETROIT  
6 CONSUMER PRICE INDEX. AS USED IN THIS SUBSECTION, "DETROIT CON-  
7 SUMER PRICE INDEX" MEANS THE MOST COMPREHENSIVE INDEX OF CONSUMER  
8 PRICES AVAILABLE FOR THE DETROIT AREA FROM THE UNITED STATES  
9 DEPARTMENT OF LABOR, BUREAU OF LABOR STATISTICS.
