



HOUSE BILL No. 6155

September 25, 1996, Introduced by Reps. Crissman, Galloway, Dolan, Dobb, Jamian, Johnson, Kaza, McBryde, Middleton, Gustafson, Dalman, Law, Gernaat and Voorhees and referred to the Committee on Local Government.

A bill to authorize local units of government to establish independent entities to employ individuals on a seasonal basis.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 1. As used in this act:

2 (a) "Local unit of government" means a city, village, town-
3 ship, county, school district, metropolitan district, or other
4 local governmental unit of or in this state.

5 (b) "Seasonal employment" means that term as defined in sec-
6 tion 27 of the Michigan employment security act, Act No. 1 of the
7 Public Acts of the Extra Session of 1936, being section 421.27 of
8 the Michigan Compiled Laws.

9 Sec. 2. The governing body of a local unit of government
10 may establish a separate and independent entity to carry out
11 seasonal functions of that local unit of government and to
12 provide individuals with seasonal employment.
