



HOUSE BILL No. 6156

September 25, 1996, Introduced by Reps. Kaza, Profit, Voorhees, Weeks, Gire, Gubow, Jellema, Freeman and Jersevic and referred to the Committee on Conservation, Environment and Great Lakes.

A bill to designate the highest point of this state; and to impose certain powers and duties on certain state officers.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 1. The summit of Mt. Arvon, located in Baraga county,
2 is the highest point in this state.

3 Sec. 2. The director of the department of natural resources
4 shall initiate negotiations with the owner or owners of the prop-
5 erty surrounding the summit of Mt. Arvon for the acquisition of
6 that property for its development as a state park.
