



SENATE BILL No. 90

January 17, 1995, Introduced by Senator VAUGHN
and referred to the Committee on Education.

A bill to amend Act No. 451 of the Public Acts of 1976,
entitled as amended

"The school code of 1976,"

as amended, being sections 380.1 to 380.1852 of the Michigan
Compiled Laws, by adding sections 1174b and 1531d.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Act No. 451 of the Public Acts of 1976, as
2 amended, being sections 380.1 to 380.1852 of the Michigan
3 Compiled Laws, is amended by adding sections 1174b and 1531d to
4 read as follows:

5 SEC. 1174B. (1) BEGINNING IN 1995, THE BOARD OF A SCHOOL
6 DISTRICT SHALL ENSURE THAT INSTRUCTION IN THE HISTORY, CULTURE,
7 AND TRIBAL SOVEREIGNTY OF THE FEDERALLY RECOGNIZED NATIVE
8 AMERICAN TRIBES AND BANDS LOCATED IN THIS STATE IS INCLUDED AS

1 PART OF THE SOCIAL STUDIES CURRICULUM AT LEAST TWICE IN THE
2 ELEMENTARY GRADES AND AT LEAST ONCE IN THE HIGH SCHOOL GRADES.

3 (2) THE DEPARTMENT, IN COOPERATION WITH THE MICHIGAN COMMIS-
4 SION ON INDIAN AFFAIRS, SHALL DEVELOP GUIDELINES FOR THE INSTRUCC-
5 TION DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (1).

6 SEC. 1531D. BEGINNING JULY 1, 1997, THE STATE BOARD SHALL
7 NOT GRANT A TEACHING CERTIFICATE TO AN APPLICANT UNLESS THE
8 APPLICANT HAS RECEIVED INSTRUCTION IN THE STUDY OF MINORITY GROUP
9 RELATIONS, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, INSTRUCTION IN THE HIS-
10 TORY, CULTURE, AND TRIBAL SOVEREIGNTY OF THE FEDERALLY RECOGNIZED
11 NATIVE AMERICAN TRIBES AND BANDS LOCATED IN THIS STATE.
