



# SENATE BILL No. 164

January 31, 1995, Introduced by Senator SHUGARS and referred to the Committee on Economic Development, International Trade and Regulatory Affairs.

A bill to amend section 303a of Act No. 299 of the Public Acts of 1980, entitled as amended "Occupational code," as added by Act No. 269 of the Public Acts of 1990, being section 339.303a of the Michigan Compiled Laws; to repeal certain parts of the act; and to repeal acts and parts of acts.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Section 303a of Act No. 299 of the Public Acts  
2 of 1980, as added by Act No. 269 of the Public Acts of 1990,  
3 being section 339.303a of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended  
4 to read as follows:
