

## SENATE BILL No. 179

January 31, 1995, Introduced by Senators SHUGARS and DUNASKISS and referred to the Committee on Financial Services.

A bill to prohibit health care providers from reporting certain information to credit reporting agencies; and to prescribe penalties.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. As used in this act:
- 2 (a) "Credit reporting agency" means a person that regularly
- 3 engages in the practice of assembling or evaluating consumer
- 4 credit information or other information on consumers for the pur-
- 5 pose of furnishing consumer reports to third parties.
- 6 (b) "Health care provider" means a person or organization
- 7 whose primary activity is the provision of health care to indi-
- 8 viduals and includes a hospital, physician, dentist, nurse, podi-
- 9 atrist, physician's assistant, or an organization comprised of
- 10 health care providers.

- 1 (c) "Person" means an individual, partnership, corporation,
- 2 association, governmental entity, or other legal entity.
- 3 Sec. 2. A health care provider shall not report to a credit
- 4 reporting agency negative credit information relating to late
- 5 payments for services of the provider if the delay in payment for
- 6 the services is due to the failure of the consumer's insurer to
- 7 make the payment when due.
- 8 Sec. 3. A person who violates this act is guilty of a mis-
- 9 demeanor, punishable by imprisonment for not more than 90 days,
- 10 or by a fine of not more than \$5,000.00, or both.
