



# SENATE BILL No. 601

June 15, 1995, Introduced by Senators HONIGMAN, GEAKE, GOUGEON, HOFFMAN, SHUGARS, BYRUM, STILLE, DUNASKISS, SCHUETTE, MCMANUS and EMMONS and referred to the Committee on Families, Mental Health and Human Services.

A bill to amend section 60 of chapter X of Act No. 288 of the Public Acts of 1939, entitled as amended

"An act to revise and consolidate the statutes relating to certain aspects of the organization and jurisdiction of the probate court of this state, the powers and duties of such court and the judges and other officers thereof, certain aspects of the statutes of descent and distribution of property, and the statutes governing the change of name of adults and children, the adoption of adults and children, and the jurisdiction of the juvenile division of the probate court; to prescribe the powers and duties of the juvenile division of the probate court, and the judges and other officers thereof; to prescribe the manner and time within which actions and proceedings may be brought in the juvenile division of the probate court; to prescribe pleading, evidence, practice, and procedure in actions and proceedings in the juvenile division of the probate court; to provide for appeals from the juvenile division of the probate court; to prescribe the powers and duties of certain state departments, agencies, and officers; and to provide remedies and penalties for the violation of this act,"

as amended by Act No. 341 of the Public Acts of 1982, being section 710.60 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.
