



# SENATE BILL No. 610

June 15, 1995, Introduced by Senators HONIGMAN, GEAKE, DINGELL, HOFFMAN, GOUGEON, SHUGARS, DUNASKISS, STILLE, SCHUETTE, MC MANUS, BYRUM, PETERS, and EMMONS and referred to the Committee on Families, Mental Health and Human Services.

A bill to amend sections 16 and 32 of Act No. 8 of the Public Acts of 1952, entitled as amended "Revised uniform reciprocal enforcement of support act," section 16 as amended and section 32 as added by Act No. 172 of the Public Acts of 1985, being sections 780.166 and 780.182 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Sections 16 and 32 of Act No. 8 of the Public  
2 Acts of 1952, section 16 as amended and section 32 as added by  
3 Act No. 172 of the Public Acts of 1985, being sections 780.166  
4 and 780.182 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, are amended to read as  
5 follows:

6 Sec. 16. (1) In addition to the foregoing powers, the court  
7 of this state when acting as a responding court may subject the

1 obligor to any terms and conditions proper to assure compliance  
2 with its orders.

3 (2) A support order entered by the court of this state when  
4 acting as a responding court shall be enforceable as provided in  
5 the support and ~~visitation~~ PARENTING TIME enforcement act, Act  
6 No. 295 of the Public Acts of 1982, being sections 552.601 to  
7 552.650 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

8 Sec. 32. (1) A proceeding ~~pursuant to~~ UNDER this act  
9 shall adjudicate only the issue of support and shall not adjudi-  
10 cate an issue of custody or ~~visitation~~ PARENTING TIME.

11 (2) Nothing in this act shall prevent a court which has  
12 prior continuing jurisdiction over the parties in matters of sup-  
13 port, custody, and ~~visitation~~ PARENTING TIME from exercising  
14 its jurisdiction over those matters.

15 Section 2. This amendatory act shall not take effect unless  
16 Senate Bill No. 624  
17 of the 88th Legislature is enacted into law.
