

# SENATE BILL No. 659

September 20, 1995, Introduced by Senator SCHUETTE and referred to the Committee on Local, Urban and State Affairs.

A bill to authorize the department of natural resources to convey certain parcels of state owned property in Newaygo county; to prescribe conditions for the conveyance; and to provide for disposition of the revenue derived from the conveyance.

### THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 1. (1) The department of natural resources, on behalf
- 2 of the state, may convey to Newaygo county, for consideration of
- 3 \$1.00, certain parcels of real property under the jurisdiction of
- 4 the department of natural resources and located in Newaygo
- 5 county, Michigan, and more particularly described as:
- 6 Parcel 1
- 7 Government Lot 1, Sec. 19, T12N, R12W,
- 8 Parcel 2
- Government Lot 2, Sec. 19, T12N, R12W,

- I except so much of said Government Lot as is part of Shaw Park,
- 2 described in a deed From Edwin O. Show to the Village of
- 3 Newaygo recorded in Liber 96, page 186, Newaygo County Records
- 4 as Beginning at the 1/4 corner between Secs. 18 and 19, th E on
- 5 sec. line 3 chains, 54 links (233.64 feet); th S 1° W 5 chains,
- 6 10 links (336.6 feet); th S 49 3/4° W 1 chain 83 1/2 links
- 7 (121.11 feet); th S 84° W 7 chains (462 feet); th N 87° W 3 1/2
- 8 chains (231 feet); th N 74° W 2 chains, 36 links (155.76 feet);

- 22 Subject to an easement to construct and maintain facilities for
- 23 transmitting and distributing electricity and/or conducting a
- 24 communications business over parts of Parcels 1, 2 and 3 as
- 25 reserved by Consumers Power Company in a deed recorded in
- 26 Series P, numbers 5985 through 5989, Newaygo County Records and
- 27 all other easements and restrictions of record.

- (2) All flowage rights on parcels 1, 2, and 3 shall be retained by the state of Michigan.
- Sec. 2. (1) The department of natural resources, on behalf 4 of the state, may convey to the city of Newaygo, for consideration of \$1.00, certain parcels of real property under the jurisdiction of the department of natural resources and located in the 7 city of Newaygo, Newaygo county, Michigan, and more particularly

8 described as:

- 10 A parcel of land in the NE 1/4 of Sec. 24, T12N, R13W, being
- part of Block B of the original plat of the Village of Newaygo,
- described as follows: Commencing at the NE corner of Sec. 24;
- th along the E line of said Sec. S 00° 26' 30" E a distance of
- 14 678 feet to the Point of Beginning; th S 75° 38' W a distance

- 22 A parcel of land in the NW 1/4 of Sec. 19, T12N, R12W, being
- 23 part of Block A and Block 11 of the original plat of the
- 24 Village of Newaygo, described as follows: all that part of
- 25 Block A and Block II that lies N and W of the side track of the
- 26 Pere Marquette Railroad which formerly led to the warehouse of
- 27 what was once the Gleaner's Clearing House Association,

- including the former mill canal, and any remaining parts of 1/2
- 2 of the dam which formerly abutted said premises,
- 3 except the right or way of the main line of the former Pere
- 4 Marquette, now CSX Railroad.
- 5 also except that part lying E'ly of a line 60 feet W'ly mea-
- 6 sured at right angles and parallel with the construction center

- 15 part of Block 11 of the original plat of the Village of
- 16 Newaygo, described as follows: The W 30 feet of a parcel
- 17 described as beginning at the SE corner of Block 11 at the
- intersection of State Street and Water Street; th W'ly along
- 19 Water Street a distance of 70 feet; th N to the former side
- 20 track of the Pere Marquette Railroad; th E'ly along said side
- 21 track to State Street; th S'ly along State Street to the point
- of beginning, containing 0.03 acres more or less.

- 24 Part of Government Lot 3, Sec. 19, T12N, R12 W, described as

- 17 Entire Block 14
- 18 Entire Block 45
- 19 North 1/2 of Lots 4 and 5 of Block 15
- 20 Block 44 except Lot 10

- 22 Lot 12 and that part of Lot 11 of Block 78 lying below the
- 23 crest of the bank on the S side of the Muskegon River.
- 24 Lots 5 and 6 of Block 116
- 25 Lots 5 and 6 of Lock 117
- 26 Lots 5 and 6 of Block 126

- Subject to an easement to construct and maintain facilities for
- 2 transmitting and distributing electricity and/or conducting a
- 3 communications business over part of Parcels 1, 2 and 3 as
- 4 reserved by consumers Power Company in a deed recorded in
- 5 Series P, numbers 5985 through 5989, Newaygo County Records and
- 6 all other easements and restrictions of record.
- 7 (2) All flowage rights on parcels 1, 2, 3, 4, and 5 shall be 8 retained by the state of Michigan.
- 9 Sec. 3. The conveyances authorized by this act shall pro-10 vide for both of the following:
- (a) That the property shall be used exclusively for public recreation purposes and shall be open to all residents of the state on the same terms, fees, and conditions; and that upon termination of that use or use for any other purpose, the state may reenter and repossess the property, terminating the grantee's state in the property, with the state assuming no liability for any improvements to the property.
- (b) That if the grantee disputes the state's exercise of its 19 right of reentry and fails to promptly deliver possession of the 20 property to the state, the attorney general, on behalf of the 21 state, may bring an action to quiet title to, and regain posses-22 sion of, the property.
- Sec. 4. The conveyances authorized by this act shall be by 24 quitclaim deed approved by the attorney general and shall provide 25 for all of the following:

- 1 (a) That the state reserve all rights to coal, oil, gas, and
- 2 other nonmetallic minerals found on, within, or under the
- 3 conveyed lands.
- 4 (b) That all flowage rights are retained by the state.
- 5 (c) That Newaygo county and the city of Newaygo allow right
- 6 of ingress and egress to the public for fishing and boating pur-
- 7 poses on the Muskegon river.
- 8 Sec. 5. The revenue received under this act shall be depos-
- 9 ited in a restricted account held by the department of natural
- 10 resources.
