



SENATE BILL No. 867

February 15, 1996, Introduced by Senators BENNETT, ROGERS, GOUGEON, HOFFMAN and CISKY and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend section 1f of Act No. 175 of the Public Acts of 1927, entitled as amended

"The code of criminal procedure,"

as amended by Act No. 195 of the Public Acts of 1994, being section 764.1f of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Section 1f of Act No. 175 of the Public Acts of
2 1927, as amended by Act No. 195 of the Public Acts of 1994, being
3 section 764.1f of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended to read
4 as follows:

5 Sec. 1f. If the prosecuting attorney has reason to believe
6 that a juvenile 15 years of age or older but less than 17 years
7 of age has violated section 83, 89, 91, 186A, 316, 317, 520b,
8 529, or 529a of the Michigan penal code, Act No. 328 of the
9 Public Acts of 1931, being sections 750.83, 750.89, 750.91,

1 750.186A, 750.316, 750.317, 750.520b, 750.529, and 750.529a of
2 the Michigan Compiled Laws, or section 7401(2)(a)(i) or
3 7403(2)(a)(i) of the public health code, Act No. 368 of the
4 Public Acts of 1978, being sections 333.7401 and 333.7403 of the
5 Michigan Compiled Laws, the prosecuting attorney may authorize
6 the filing of a complaint and warrant on the charge with a magis-
7 trate concerning the juvenile.

8 Section 2. This amendatory act shall not take effect unless
9 all of the following bills of the 88th Legislature are enacted
10 into law:
