

SENATE BILL No. 927

March 12, 1996, Introduced by Senator GOUGEON and referred to the Committee on Transportation and Tourism.

A bill to amend section 803a of Act No. 300 of the Public Acts of 1949, entitled as amended

"Michigan vehicle code,"

as amended by Act No. 347 of the Public Acts of 1990, being section 257.803a of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Section 1. Section 803a of Act No. 300 of the Public Acts
- 2 of 1949, as amended by Act No. 347 of the Public Acts of 1990,
- 3 being section 257.803a of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended
- 4 to read as follows:
- Sec. 803a. (1) As used in this section, "historic vehicle"
- 6 means a vehicle which is over 25 years old, and which is owned
- 7 solely as a collector's item and for participation in club
- 8 activities, exhibitions, tours, parades, and similar uses, but is
- 9 not used for general transportation.

- 1 (2) The secretary of state may issue to the owner of an 2 historic vehicle an historic vehicle registration plate which 3 shall bear the inscription "historical vehicle Michigan" and 4 the registration number.
- (3) The secretary of state may issue to the owner of an 6 historic vehicle who possesses an authentic Michigan registration 7 plate of the same year as the model year in which the vehicle was 8 manufactured a registration tab which may be attached to the 9 authentic plate. The registration tab shall be an adhesive tab. 10 The owner of an historic vehicle may use an authentic plate to 11 which a registration tab, issued to him or her under this subsec-12 tion, is attached instead of an historic vehicle registration 13 plate issued under subsection (2). The owner of an historic 14 vehicle may purchase an authentic plate from another person for 15 use pursuant to this section. THE OWNER OF AN HISTORIC VEHICLE 16 MAY USE AN AUTHENTIC MICHIGAN REGISTRATION PLATE OF THE SAME YEAR 17 AS THE MODEL YEAR IN WHICH THE VEHICLE WAS MANUFACTURED INSTEAD 18 OF AN HISTORIC VEHICLE REGISTRATION PLATE ISSUED UNDER SUBSECTION 19 (2) BY PRESENTING THE AUTHENTIC PLATE NUMBER AND YEAR TO THE SEC-20 RETARY OF STATE AT THE TIME OF REGISTRATION. THE OWNER OF AN 21 HISTORIC VEHICLE MAY PURCHASE AN AUTHENTIC MICHIGAN REGISTRATION 22 PLATE FROM ANOTHER PERSON FOR USE PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION.
- 25 (4) The owner of an historic vehicle applying for an his-26 toric vehicle registration plate or a registration —tab—OF AN 27 AUTHENTIC MICHIGAN REGISTRATION PLATE under this section shall

23 AUTHENTICALLY RESTORED PLATE SHALL BE CONSIDERED AN AUTHENTIC

24 MICHIGAN REGISTRATION PLATE.

- pay a fee of \$15.00-\$35.00, shall certify that the vehicle for which the registration is requested is owned and operated solely for the purposes enumerated in subsection (1), and shall certify that the vehicle has been inspected and found safe to operate on the highways of this state. The registration certificate need not specify the weight of the historic vehicle. The registration issued under this section is transferrable to another historical vehicle upon completion of the application for transfer and payment of the fee in the manner described in section 809.
- (5) A registration issued under this section shall -expire

 11 on April +5 in the fifth year following the date of issuance of

 12 the registration- BE VALID WITHOUT RENEWAL AS LONG AS THE VEHICLE

 13 IS IN EXISTENCE. However, a registration issued under this sec

 14 tion prior to April +5, 1988 shall expire on April +5, 1993.
- (6) The secretary of state may revoke a registration issued under this section, for cause shown and after a hearing, for failure of the applicant to comply with this section, for use of the vehicle for which the registration was issued for purposes other than those enumerated in subsection (1), or because the vehicle is not safe to operate on the highways of this state.
