



SENATE BILL No. 979

April 24, 1996, Introduced by Senators MC MANUS, GAST, STEIL, GEAKE, ROGERS, BENNETT and SCHUETTE and referred to the Committee on Appropriations.

A bill to make appropriations for the department of natural resources; to provide for the acquisition of land; to provide for the development of public recreation facilities; to provide for the powers and duties of certain state agencies and officials; and to provide for the expenditure of appropriations.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 1. There is appropriated for the department of natural
2 resources to supplement former appropriations for the fiscal year ending
3 September 30, 1996, the sum of \$18,930,000.00 for land acquisition and
4 grants and \$5,688,800.00 for public recreation facility development and
5 grants as provided in section 35 of article IX of the state constitution
6 of 1963 and part 19 (natural resources trust fund) of the natural
7 resources and environmental protection act, Act No. 451 of the Public
8 Acts of 1994, being sections 324.1901 to 324.1910 of the Michigan
9 Compiled Laws, from the following funds:

- 21 Sec. 3. The department of natural resources shall enter into agree-
- 22 ments with local units of government for the purpose of administering the
- 23 grants identified in section 1. Among other provisions, the agreements
- 24 shall require that grant recipients agree to dedicate to public recre-
- 25 ation uses in perpetuity the land acquired; to replace lands converted or
- 26 lost to other than public recreation use; and to convey to the state any
- 27 mineral interests acquired by the grant recipient with an exception

1 allowed for a share of the mineral interests acquired, which share is
2 based on the portion of the fair market value of the property that was

12 Sec. 5. Any unobligated balance in any appropriation made under
13 section 1 shall not revert to the fund from which appropriated at the
14 close of the fiscal year, but shall continue until the purpose for which
15 it was appropriated is completed. The unexpended balance of any appro-
16 priation made in section 1 remaining after the purpose for which it was
17 appropriated is completed shall revert to the Michigan natural resources
18 trust fund and be made available for appropriation.

19 Sec. 6. If a person or organization has acquired an option on a
20 parcel of property prior to final determination by the department of nat-
21 ural resources and the Michigan natural resources trust fund board, the
22 property shall not be considered for acquisition unless the department
23 and board can demonstrate that a clear recreational advantage exists in
24 obtaining the parcel of property for the people of the state at a reason-
25 able fair market value.

26 Sec. 7. As required by section 1903(3) of part 19 (natural
27 resources trust fund) of the natural resources and environmental

1 protection act, Act No. 451 of the Public Acts of 1994, being section
2 324.1903 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, the grants-in-aid to local units
3 of government shall be awarded pursuant to this act.

4 Sec. 8. The appropriation in section 1. A. (priority no. 18) for
5 boating lump sum access sites acquisition (#95-305) shall not be expended
6 for land acquisition on a lake not specifically identified.
