



SENATE BILL No. 1054

May 28, 1996, Introduced by Senator HOFFMAN and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend section 2b of Act No. 2 of the Public Acts of 1968, entitled as amended "Uniform budgeting and accounting act," being section 141.422b of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Section 2b of Act No. 2 of the Public Acts of
2 1968, being section 141.422b of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is
3 amended to read as follows:

4 Sec. 2b. (1) "Budgetary center" means a general operating
5 department of a local unit or any other department, institution,
6 COURT, board, commission, agency, office, program, activity, or
7 function to which money is appropriated by the local unit.

8 (2) "Capital outlay" means a disbursement of money which
9 results in the acquisition of, or addition to, fixed assets.

1 (3) "Chief administrative officer" means any of the
2 following:

3 (a) The manager of a village or, if a village does not
4 employ a manager, the president of the village.

5 (b) The city manager of a city or, if a city does not employ
6 a city manager, the mayor of the city.

7 (c) The superintendent of a local school district, or if the
8 school district does not have a superintendent, the person having
9 general administrative control of the school district.

10 (d) The superintendent of an intermediate school district,
11 or if the school district does not have a superintendent, the
12 person having general administrative control of the school
13 district.

14 (e) The manager of a township, or if the township does not
15 employ a manager, the supervisor of the township.

16 (f) The elected county executive or appointed county manager
17 of a county; or if the county has not adopted an optional unified
18 form of county government, the controller of the county appointed
19 pursuant to section 13b of Act No. 156 of the Public Acts of
20 1851, ~~as amended,~~ being section 46.13b of the Michigan Compiled
21 Laws; or if the county has not appointed a controller, an indi-
22 vidual designated by the county board of commissioners of the
23 county.

24 (g) The official granted general administrative control of
25 an authority or organization of government established by law
26 which may issue obligations pursuant to THE MUNICIPAL FINANCE
27 ACT, Act No. 202 of the Public Acts of 1943, ~~as amended,~~ being

1 sections 131.1 to ~~138.2~~ 139.3 of the Michigan Compiled Laws,
2 and which either may levy a property tax or may expend funds of
3 the authority or organization.

4 (4) "Deficit" means an excess of liabilities and reserves of
5 a fund over its assets.

6 (5) "Disbursement" means a payment in cash.
