

## **SENATE BILL No. 1074**

July 3, 1996, Introduced by Senator STILLE and referred to the Committee on Financial Services.

A bill to amend sections 2, 3, 6, 12, 13, and 15 of Act No. 291 of the Public Acts of 1966, entitled as amended "Fire fighters training council act of 1966," sections 2 and 3 as amended by Act No. 196 of the Public Acts of 1987 and section 6 as amended by Act No. 10 of the Public Acts of 1980, being sections 29.362, 29.363, 29.366, 29.372, 29.373, and 29.375 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Section 1. Sections 2, 3, 6, 12, 13, and 15 of Act No. 291
- 2 of the Public Acts of 1966, sections 2 and 3 as amended by Act
- 3 No. 196 of the Public Acts of 1987 and section 6 as amended by
- 4 Act No. 10 of the Public Acts of 1980, being sections 29.362,
- 5 29.363, 29.366, 29.372, 29.373, and 29.375 of the Michigan
- 6 Compiled Laws, are amended to read as follows:

- 1 Sec. 2. As used in this act:
- 2 (a) "Council" means the fire fighters training council.
- 3 (B) "ELIGIBLE ENTITY" MEANS A VILLAGE, CITY, TOWNSHIP, OR
- 4 COUNTY THAT HAS ESTABLISHED OR THAT RECOGNIZES AN ORGANIZATION
- 5 FOR THE PURPOSES OF THE PREVENTION, DETECTION, AND EXTINGUISHMENT
- 6 OF FIRES AND THE ENFORCEMENT OF FIRE LAWS IN THIS STATE.
- 7 (C) -(b) "Executive secretary" means the executive secre-
- 8 tary of the council.
- 9 (D) -(c) "Fire fighter" means a member, including volunteer
- 10 members and members paid on call, of a fire department or other
- 11 organization of a city, county, township, or village who is
- 12 responsible for, or is in a capacity which THAT includes
- 13 responsibility for, the extinguishment of fires, the directing of
- 14 the extinguishment of fires, the prevention and detection of
- 15 fires, and the enforcement of the general fire laws of this
- 16 state. This definition shall not apply to FIRE FIGHTER DOES
- 17 NOT INCLUDE a person whose job description, duties, or responsi-
- 18 bilities do not include direct involvement in fire suppression.
- (E) (d) "Fire department or other organization" means an
- 20 organization or department -which THAT provides fire suppression
- 21 and other fire-related services within a city, village, township,
- 22 or county.
- 23 Sec. 3. (1) The fire fighters training council is -hereby-
- 24 created within the department of state police and shall consist
- 25 of  $\frac{7}{2}$  9 members selected as follows:

- 1 (a) The director of THE DEPARTMENT OF state police, or his 2 or her designated representative, shall be ex officio a AS AN 3 EX OFFICIO member.
- 4 (b) Two members appointed to the council by the governor 5 from a list of 5 active members submitted by the Michigan fire 6 chief's association.
- 7 (c) One member appointed to the council by the governor from 8 a list of 3 active fire fighters submitted by the Michigan state 9 fire fighter's association.
- (d) One member appointed to the council by the governor from II a list of 3 names submitted by the Michigan state firemen's 12 association.
- (e) One member appointed to the council by the governor from 14 a list of 3 names submitted by the metropolitan club of America, 15 incorporated MICHIGAN INSURANCE FEDERATION.
- (f) One member appointed to the council by the governor from 17 a list of 2 names submitted by the Michigan townships associa.

- 21 (G) ONE MEMBER APPOINTED TO THE COUNCIL BY THE GOVERNOR FROM 22 A LIST OF 3 NAMES SUBMITTED BY THE MICHIGAN MUNICIPAL LEAGUE.
- 23 (H) ONE MEMBER APPOINTED TO THE COUNCIL BY THE GOVERNOR FROM
  24 A LIST OF 3 NAMES SUBMITTED BY THE MICHIGAN TOWNSHIPS
  25 ASSOCIATION.
- 26 (2) All appointments TO THE COUNCIL made by the governor 27 shall be with the advice and consent of the senate.

- 1 Sec. 6. (1) The council shall meet at least 4 times each
- 2 year and shall hold special meetings when called by the chair-
- 3 person or, in the absence of the chairperson, by the
- 4 vice-chairperson or when called by the chairperson upon the writ-
- 5 ten request of -4 6 members of the council.
- 6 (2) The business which THAT the council may perform shall
- 7 be conducted at a public meeting of the council held in compli-
- 8 ance with THE OPEN MEETINGS ACT, Act No. 267 of the Public Acts
- 9 of 1976, as amended, being sections 15.261 to 15.275 of the
- 10 Michigan Compiled Laws. Public notice of the time, date, and
- 11 place of the meeting shall be given in the manner required by Act
- 12 No. 267 of the Public Acts of 1976. , as amended.
- (3) The council shall establish its own procedures and
- 14 requirements with respect to quorum, place, and conduct of its
- 15 meetings and other matters.
- 16 Sec. 12. (1) There THE COUNCIL shall be APPOINT an
- 17 executive secretary of the council who shall be appointed by the
- 18 council, and who shall hold office during the pleasure of the
- 19 council. He OR SHE shall perform such functions and duties as
- 20 may be assigned to him by the council. He OR SHE shall
- 21 receive compensation and reimbursement for expenses within the
- 22 amounts available by appropriation.
- 23 (2) THE COUNCIL SHALL APPOINT A FINANCIAL OFFICER OF THE
- 24 COUNCIL WHO SHALL HOLD OFFICE DURING THE PLEASURE OF THE
- **25** COUNCIL. HE OR SHE SHALL MANAGE AND DISBURSE THE FIRE FIGHTERS
- 26 TRAINING FUND CREATED IN SECTION 13. THE FINANCIAL OFFICER SHALL
- 27 COLLECT TRAINING REPORTS FROM ELIGIBLE ENTITIES RECEIVING

- 1 DISBURSEMENTS FROM THE FIRE FIGHTERS TRAINING FUND AND SHALL
- 2 COLLECT AND SUBMIT FOR COUNCIL ACTION REQUESTS FOR GRANTS FROM
- 3 THE FIRE FIGHTERS TRAINING FUND. HE OR SHE SHALL RECEIVE COMPEN-
- 4 SATION AND REIMBURSEMENT FOR EXPENSES WITHIN THE AMOUNTS AVAIL-
- 5 ABLE BY APPROPRIATION.
- 6 Sez. 13. (1) There is created in the state treasury a fire
- 7 fighters training fund. -from which the legislature shall appro-
- 8 priate such sums as are deemed necessary for the purposes of this
- 9 act but in no case shall such appropriations be in excess of 75%
- 10 of the amounts paid into the fund. THE MONEY IN THE FUND IS
- 11 RESTRICTED AND SHALL NOT REVERT TO THE GENERAL FUND AT THE END OF
- 12 ANY FISCAL YEAR AND SHALL BE AVAILABLE FOR THE PURPOSES FOR WHICH
- 13 THE FUND WAS CREATED. ANY INTEREST OR EARNINGS OF THE FUND SHALL
- 14 BE DEPOSITED BACK INTO THE FUND. THE FUND SHALL BE AUDITED BY
- 15 THE AUDITOR GENERAL EVERY 2 YEARS.
- 16 (2) THE FIRE FIGHTERS TRAINING FUND IS COMPRISED OF MONEY
- 17 COLLECTED PURSUANT TO SECTION 452 OF THE INSURANCE CODE OF 1956,
- 18 ACT NO. 218 OF THE PUBLIC ACTS OF 1956, BEING SECTION 500.452 OF
- 19 THE MICHIGAN COMPILED LAWS.
- 20 (3) THE COUNCIL SHALL DISTRIBUTE THE FIRE FIGHTERS TRAINING
- 21 FUND IN THE FOLLOWING MANNER:
- 22 (A) EIGHTY PERCENT OF THE FUND SHALL BE DISTRIBUTED TO THE
- 23 ELIGIBLE ENTITIES TO BE USED FOR THE IN-SERVICE OR ADVANCED
- 24 TRAINING OF THE MEMBERS OF THE ELIGIBLE ENTITIES.
- 25 (B) TWELVE PERCENT OF THE FUND SHALL BE USED FOR THE TRAIN-
- 26 ING EXPENSES OF THE COUNCIL.

- 1 (C) THREE PERCENT OF THE FUND SHALL BE USED TO FUND A
- 2 FINANCIAL OFFICER FOR THE MANAGEMENT AND DISTRIBUTION OF THE FUND
- 3 AND FOR RECEIVING ANNUAL TRAINING REPORTS FROM ELIGIBLE ENTITIES
- 4 RECEIVING DISBURSEMENTS.
- 5 (D) FIVE PERCENT OF THE FUND SHALL BE RESERVED FOR GRANT
- 6 REQUESTS SUBMITTED TO THE COUNCIL.
- 7 (5) A DISBURSEMENT UNDER THIS SECTION IS SUPPLEMENTAL TO,
- 8 AND NOT A REPLACEMENT FOR, FUNDS BUDGETED ON OR BEFORE JULY 1,
- 9 1995 BY AN ELIGIBLE ENTITY FOR THE IN-SERVICE OR ADVANCED TRAIN-
- 10 ING OF ITS FIRE FIGHTERS.
- 11 (6) AN ELIGIBLE ENTITY RECEIVING A DISBURSEMENT UNDER THIS
- 12 SECTION SHALL USE THE ENTIRE DISBURSEMENT FOR THE IN-SERVICE OR
- 13 ADVANCED TRAINING OF FIRE FIGHTERS. THAT TRAINING SHALL OCCUR
- 14 WITHIN 3 YEARS AFTER RECEIVING THE DISBURSEMENT. AN ELIGIBLE
- 15 ENTITY FAILING OR REFUSING TO USE THE DISBURSEMENT IN THE MANNER
- 16 PROVIDED FOR IN THIS SUBSECTION IS DISQUALIFIED FROM RECEIVING AN
- 17 ADDITIONAL DISBURSEMENT UNTIL THE ELIGIBLE ENTITY DEMONSTRATES TO
- 18 THE COUNCIL THAT THE ENTIRE PRIOR DISBURSEMENT WAS USED IN THE
- 19 MANNER PROVIDED FOR IN THIS SUBSECTION.
- 20 (7) THE DISBURSEMENTS SHALL BE MADE IN 2 SEMIANNUAL INSTALL-
- 21 MENTS ON DATES DETERMINED BY THE COUNCIL. THE FUND SHALL BE DIS-
- 22 BURSED TO ELIGIBLE ENTITIES ON A PER CAPITA BASIS OF FIRE FIGHT-
- 23 ERS EMPLOYED BY THE ELIGIBLE ENTITIES. EACH QUALIFIED ELIGIBLE
- 24 ENTITY SHALL RECEIVE A MINIMUM DISBURSEMENT OF \$500.00.
- 25 (8) AN ELIGIBLE ENTITY SHALL MAKE AND MAINTAIN DETAILED
- 26 RECORDS OF THE ACTUAL COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH THE PREPARATION FOR,
- 27 THE ADMINISTRATION OF, AND THE CONDUCT OF A TRAINING PROGRAM

- 1 FINANCED IN WHOLE OR IN PART BY A DISBURSEMENT UNDER THIS SECTION
- 2 AND SHALL ANNUALLY REPORT TO THE COUNCIL ON THE RESULTS OF ITS
- 3 TRAINING PROGRAMS. THE ELIGIBLE ENTITY SHALL SEPARATELY IDENTIFY
- 4 EACH PROGRAM.
- 5 (9) THE COUNCIL SHALL ANNUALLY REPORT TO THE LEGISLATURE ON
- 6 THE RESULTS OF THE DISBURSEMENTS.
- 7 (10) MONEY SHALL NOT BE DISBURSED UNDER THIS SECTION FOR ANY
- 8 OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 9 (A) TRAINING CONDUCTED BY A PROVIDER NOT BASED IN THIS STATE
- 10 OR TRAINING NOT OCCURRING IN THIS STATE OR COUNTRY UNLESS THE
- 11 TRAINING HAS BEEN APPROVED BY THE COUNCIL.
- 12 (B) MEAL EXPENDITURES IN EXCESS OF THE PER DIEM MEAL EXPEN-
- 13 DITURES AUTHORIZED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF MANAGEMENT AND BUDGET FOR
- 14 CIVIL SERVICE EMPLOYEES.
- 15 (C) EXPENDITURES FOR ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES.
- 16 (D) TRAVEL COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH TRAINING PROGRAMS UNLESS
- 17 THE FIRE FIGHTER TRAINING IS THE SOLE PURPOSE OF THE PROGRAM OR
- 18 UNLESS THE PROGRAM OFFERS AT LEAST 6 HOURS OF QUALIFIED TRAINING
- 19 WITHIN A 24-HOUR PERIOD.
- 20 (E) THE PUBLICATION OF A NEWSLETTER.
- 21 Sec. 15. (1) Any city, county, township or village which
- 22 ELIGIBLE ENTITY THAT desires to receive -aid- A DISBURSEMENT pur-
- 23 suant to this act SECTION 13 shall make application APPLY to
- 24 the council for such -aid DISBURSEMENT.
- 25 (2) A DISBURSEMENT SHALL BE IN COMPLIANCE WITH SECTION 13(5)
- 26 AND (6).

- (3) A DISBURSEMENT SHALL BE MADE ONLY TO 1 OR BOTH OF THE 2 FOLLOWING:
- (A) A STATE OR LOCAL AGENCY PROVIDING IN-SERVICE FIRE 3
- 4 FIGHTING TRAINING TO ITS EMPLOYEES.
- (B) A STATE OR LOCAL AGENCY PROVIDING FIRE FIGHTING TRAINING 5
- 6 TO EMPLOYEES OR TO THE CONTRACTUAL SERVICE PROVIDERS OF ANOTHER
- 7 STATE OF LOCAL AGENCY. A DISBURSEMENT UNDER THIS SECTION IS IN
- 8 ADDITION TO ANY OTHER FUNDS AVAILABLE FOR FIRE FIGHTER TRAINING.
- (4) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "FIRE FIGHTER TRAINING" MEANS
- 10 TRAINING DESIGNED AND INTENDED TO ENHANCE THE DIRECT DELIVERY OF
- 11 FIRE FIGHTING SERVICES BY EMPLOYEES OF STATE AND LOCAL AGENCIES
- 12 WHICH IS NOT THE REQUIRED MINIMUM BASIC TRAINING FOR FIRE FIGHT-
- 13 ERS, IS NOT THE INITIAL TRAINING FOR EMPLOYEES OTHER THAN FIRE
- 14 FIGHTERS, AND IS 1 OR MORE OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 15 (A) A PROGRAM PRESENTED BY THE STATE OR LOCAL AGENCY ITSELF
- 16 OR BY A CONTRACTUAL PROVIDER HIRED BY THAT STATE OR LOCAL
- 17 AGENCY.
- 18 (B) A COURSE OR INSTRUCTION PACKAGE PROVIDED TO AN ELIGIBLE
- 19 TRAINEE FOR THE PAYMENT OF A FEE OR TUITION.
- 20 (C) SELF-EDUCATION PRESENTED BY MEANS OF AUDIOVISUAL
- 21 MATERIALS.
- Section 2. This amendatory act shall not take effect unless
