

SENATE BILL No. 1088

July 3, 1996, Introduced by Senator A. SMITH and referred to the Committee on Government Operations.

A bill to amend section 4 of Act No. 472 of the Public Acts of 1978, entitled

"An act to regulate political activity; to regulate lobbyists, lobbyist agents, and lobbying activities; to require registration of lobbyists and lobbyist agents; to require the filing of reports; to prescribe the powers and duties of the department of state; to prescribe penalties; and to repeal acts and parts of acts."

being section 4.414 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Section 1. Section 4 of Act No. 472 of the Public Acts of
- 2 1978, being section 4.414 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is
- 3 amended to read as follows:
- 4 Sec. 4. (1) "Gift" means a payment, advance, forbearance,
- 5 or the rendering or deposit of money, services, or anything of
- 6 value, the value of which exceeds \$25.00 in any 1 month period,

- 2 therefor. Gift does not include:
- 3 (a) A campaign contribution otherwise reported as required
- 4 by THE MICHIGAN CAMPAIGN FINANCE ACT, Act No. 388 of the Public
- 5 Acts of 1976, as amended, being sections 169.201 to 169.282 of
- 6 the Michigan Compiled Laws.
- 7 (b) A loan made in the normal course of business by an
- 8 institution as defined in section 5 of THE BANKING CODE OF 1969,
- 9 Act No. 319 of the Public Acts of 1969, as amended, being sec-
- 10 tion 487.305 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, a national bank, a
- 11 branch bank, an insurance company issuing a loan or receiving a
- 12 mortgage in the normal course of business, a premium finance com-
- 13 pany, a mortgage company, a small loan company, a state or fed-
- 14 eral credit union, a savings and loan association chartered by
- 15 this state or the federal government; or a licensee as defined by
- 16 THE MOTOR VEHICLE SALES FINANCE ACT, Act No. 27 of the Public
- 17 Acts of the Extra Session of 1950, as amended, being sections
- 18 492.101 to 492.141 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.
- (c) A gift received from a member of the person's immediate
- 20 family, a relative of a spouse, a relative within the seventh
- 21 degree of consanguinity as computed by the civil law method, or
- 22 from the spouse of the relative.
- 23 (d) A breakfast, luncheon, dinner, or other refreshment con-
- 24 sisting of food and beverage provided for immediate consumption.
- 25 (e) A donation to an officeholder expense fund otherwise
- 26 reported as required by Act No. 388 of the Public Acts of 1976,

- 1 as amended, being sections +69.201 to +69.282 of the Michigan
- 2 Compiled Laws.
- 3 (2) "Immediate family" means a child residing in an
- 4 individual's household, a spouse of an individual, or an individ-
- 5 ual claimed by that individual or that individual's spouse as a
- 6 dependent for federal income tax purposes.
- 7 (3) "Loan" means a transfer of money, property, or anything
- 8 of ascertainable value in exchange for an obligation, conditional
- 9 or not, to repay in whole or in part.
