

## **SENATE BILL No. 1120**

September 10, 1996, Introduced by Senator BOUCHARD and referred to the Committee on Transportation and Tourism.

A bill to amend sections 204a and 232 of Act No. 300 of the Public Acts of 1949, entitled as amended "Michigan vehicle code,"

section 204a as amended by Act No. 102 of the Public Acts of 1996, being sections 257.204a and 257.232 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Section 1. Sections 204a and 232 of Act No. 300 of the
- 2 Public Acts of 1949, section 204a as amended by Act No. 102 of
- 3 the Public Acts of 1996, being sections 257.204a and 257.232 of
- 4 the Michigan Compiled Laws, are amended to read as follows:
- Sec. 204a. (1) The secretary of state shall create and
- 6 maintain a computerized central file that provides an individual,
- 7 historical driving record for a person, including a nonresident,
- 8 with respect to all of the following:

- 1 (a) A license issued to the person under chapter 3.
- 2 (b) A conviction or civil infraction determination entered
- 3 against the person for a violation of this act or a local ordi-
- 4 nance substantially corresponding to a provision of this act.
- 5 (c) A failure of the person to comply with an order or judg-
- 6 ment issued pursuant to section 907.
- 7 (d) A cancellation, denial, revocation, suspension, or
- 8 restriction of the person's operating privilege under this act.
- 9 (e) An accident in which the person is involved.
- (f) A conviction of the person for an offense described in
- 11 section 319e.
- 12 (G) A REPORT OR EVALUATION OF THE PERSON'S PHYSICAL OR
- 13 MENTAL, OR BOTH, ABILITY TO OPERATE A MOTOR VEHICLE.
- (H)  $\frac{(g)}{(g)}$  Any other information received by the secretary of
- 15 state regarding the person that is required to be maintained as
- 16 part of the person's driving record as provided by law.
- 17 (2) A secretary of state certified computer-generated or
- 18 paper copy of an order, record, or paper maintained in the com-
- 19 puterized central file of the secretary of state is admissible in
- 20 evidence in the same manner as the original and is prima facie
- 21 proof of the contents of and the facts stated in the original.
- 22 (3) An order, record, or paper generated by the computerized
- 23 central file of the secretary of state may be certified electron-
- 24 ically by the generating computer. The certification shall be a
- 25 certification of the order, record, or paper as it appeared on a
- 26 specific date.

- 1 (4) A court or the office of the clerk of a court of this
- 2 state which is electronically connected by a terminal device to
- 3 the computerized central file of the secretary of state may
- 4 receive into and use as evidence in any case the
- 5 computer-generated certified information obtained by the terminal
- 6 device from the file. A duly authorized employee of a court of
- 7 record of this state may order a record for an individual from a
- 8 secretary of state computer terminal device located in, and under
- 9 the control of, the court, and certify in writing that the docu-
- 10 ment was produced from the terminal and that the document was not
- 11 altered in any way.
- 12 Sec. 232. (1) The secretary of state shall furnish to
- 13 chiefs of police in cities of an estimated population of 10,000
- 14 or more and to sheriffs of counties, a list of the motor vehicle
- 15 registrations and such information relating thereto as may be
- 16 necessary. The secretary of state is hereby authorized to MAY
- 17 sell any surplus lists the may publish PUBLISHED BY THE SECRE-
- 18 TARY OF STATE, and fix a reasonable price therefor, the FOR THE
- 19 SALES. THE proceeds of such FROM THE sales to be added SHALL
- 20 BE CREDITED to the state highway MICHIGAN TRANSPORTATION fund.

- 22 (2) The secretary of state -is hereby authorized to MAY
- 23 sell, or contract for the sale of, any motor vehicle registration
- 24 lists in addition to those distributed at no cost under this sec-
- 25 tion and, -to- EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS ACT, MAY sell
- 26 or furnish any other information from the records of the
- 27 department pertaining to the sale, ownership, and operation of

- 1 motor vehicles. The secretary of state shall fix a reasonable
- 2 price or charge for the sale of such lists or other information
- 3 and the proceeds therefrom shall be -added CREDITED to the
- 4 state highway fund provided for herein MICHIGAN TRANSPORTATION
- 5 FUND.
- 6 (3) RECORDS OF THE DEPARTMENT DESCRIBED IN SECTION
- 7 204A(1)(G) ARE ONLY AVAILABLE TO THE SECRETARY OF STATE AND LAW
- 8 ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES.
